

A Message from the Senior Parent Grad Night Committee

Dear Parents and Guardians of the Class of 2023,

Now that Winter Formal is behind us, I am hoping we can now look forward to our upcoming Graduation Festivities. Part of the celebration includes the Grad Night Party which is happening on Thursday, May 25th from 11:00 P.M. to 3:00 A.M. This is a fun opportunity for your student(s) to celebrate with their peers in a safe environment.

There are two main reasons the location of the event is kept secret: One is to keep the students guessing about the location, which adds to the fun, and the second, and most important, is safety. If the location is known to our students' friends who attend other schools, we will run the risk of gatecrashing or other issues. Just for your information, the location is about 45 minutes to 1 hour away. The name of the venue will not be released until the evening of the event.

With Senior Prom scheduled for the weekend before graduation, I encourage you to buy your senior's GRAD NIGHT ticket early to prevent a big hit to your pocketbook. The cost of a Grad Night ticket is **\$130.00** which covers the cost of the venue, all activities and games, food, snacks, beverages, and transportation. **After March 24th**, the price will increase to **\$145.00**. The deadline to purchase tickets is **Wednesday, May 10th**. Unfortunately, there will be no refunds unless the event is canceled. We will accept cash and checks only. All checks should be made payable to "Terra Nova PTO". Please specify in the notes - Grad Night 2023. **There is a minimum amount of tickets we need to sell to put on this event.**

Our goal is to make this opportunity accessible so **ALL** seniors may attend the memorable and safe celebration. Some students have financial hardships. 

FAFSA/CADAA Financial Aid Information

The deadline to submit your financial aid application is approaching soon on March 2nd. If you have not yet done so, please submit your applications ASAP.

The Terra Nova Counseling Department would like to share important information regarding how your student can receive free money to pay for college!



What is the FAFSA?

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is an application to determine eligibility for federal student aid The FAFSA must be completed in order to apply and be considered for federal student aid such as federal grants, work-study, and loans.

Many states and colleges use FAFSA information to determine eligibility for state and school aid. Completing and submitting the FAFSA is free.

What is CADAA?

The California Dream Act Application (CADAA) allows students interested in attending eligible California Colleges, Universities, and Career Education Programs to apply for state financial aid.

University of California, Merced | Deadline Extended


