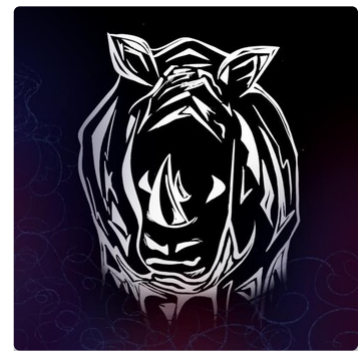

SPRING 2023 IS FREE AT CAÑADA COLLEGE, COLLEGE OF SAN MATEO AND SKYLINE COLLEGE

Thanks to the overwhelming community support of San Mateo County Community College District's *Free Community College Initiative*, Governor Newsom signed Senate Bill 893. **Now Cañada College, College of San Mateo and Skyline College can waive enrollment fees for students who reside in San Mateo County for the Spring 2023 semester** (exceptions apply). There are no minimum or maximum units required.

Depending on documented financial need, students may also be exempted from paying the student body fee, student representation fee, student union fee, inclusive access fee(s), and materials fees associated with the course.

Gracias al extraordinario apoyo de la comunidad en la Iniciativa de *Colegios Comunitarios Gratuitos* de San Mateo County Community College District, el Gobernador Newsom firmó el Proyecto de Ley del Senado 893. **Ahora Cañada College, College of San Mateo y Skyline College no exigirán las cuotas de matriculación para los estudiantes que residen en el Condado de San Mateo durante el semestre de la primavera de 2023** (se aplicarán excepciones). No se requieren unidades mínimas ni máximas.

Dependiendo de la necesidad financiera con documentos, los estudiantes también no pagarían la cuota del estudiantado, la cuota de representación de los estudiantes, la cuota del sindicato de estudiantes, las cuotas de acceso inclusivo y las cuotas de materiales asociados con el curso.

What is the FAFSA?

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is an application to determine eligibility for federal student aid. The FAFSA must be completed in order to apply and be considered for federal student aid such as federal grants, work-study, and loans.

Many states and colleges use FAFSA information to determine eligibility for state and school aid. Completing and submitting the FAFSA is free.

What is CADAA?

The California Dream Act Application (CADAA) allows students interested in attending eligible California Colleges, Universities, and Career Education Programs to apply for state financial aid.
