Dear Terra Nova families,

- Tickets are not sold at the door & late tickets will not be sold
- Tickets can't be resold or transferred to another individual. Only the original purchaser of the ticket will be allowed into the dance.

If your student wishes to bring a non-Terra Nova student to the dance, they must submit a completed guest pass form in order to purchase a ticket.

- Guest passes form are available in the Main Office.
- Guest pass forms require a picture of the guest's student id or driver license and be signed by their school principal or vice principal.
- Once the guest has completed the form, the TN student turns it into the Main Office for review
- TN Administration reviews the form and will give final approval to the guest
- The approved guest pass form will be returned to the student
- The TN student must purchase both tickets at the same time and turn in the approved guest pass form at the time of purchase
- Students are allowed one guest

The dance will take place on Saturday, October 22nd from 7-10:00 pm in the cafeteria. It ends promptly at 10:00 so please be sure your student has transportation from the dance arranged ahead of time.

The homecoming football game is our last regular season home game and we are expecting a large crowd. Please consider volunteering in the snack shack - it's the number one fundraiser for our athletic booster club and any help is greatly appreciated.




