The California Universal Meals Program has been established for this school year. Through this program, the state is reimbursing the school district for meals. All students may get one free breakfast and one free lunch each day by providing their student ID number at the register in the cafeteria. Additional meals are available for purchase at full price.



Our snack bar will be up and running later this month where additional snack items will be available for purchase.

Any student balance left from last year on myschoolbucks has been transferred to your student's new account on our Titan system.





Terra Nova would like to introduce Marisa Pearce, our new Wellness Counselor, and Noah Marsh, our new School Social Worker.




WHAT WE DO
