PAPER is a 24-7, online tutoring program where students can get on-demand live chat assistance with expert tutors in multiple subjects including writing support.

Students are able to login to PAPER using their school username/password at https://app.paper.co/login/student.

They will receive help within seconds in multiple subjects. Students can also submit any written work, including essays, lab reports, research papers or college application essays. Tutors provide detailed notes on grammar, structure and content. Work is even checked for missed citations or plagiarism.
