- The Outdoor Ed Program is requiring students be vaccinated for COVID in order to be Cabin Leaders.
- Students **MUST** UPLOAD Proof of Vaccination(Vaccine Card) and Completed Teachers of Cabin Leader Form to the Outdoor Ed application. ( Take a picture and attach )

### **Outdoor Education Registration Packet**

A negative covid test is **REQUIRED** within **THREE** days prior to the Monday that the students depart for Outdoor Education. The Friday Morning before attending outdoor education families will have their child tested and submit a negative test to the school staff when they arrive on Monday.( At home tests are not accepted)
