What is Flex Time?

Flex Time is a 30 minute academic period two days a week where all students are given an opportunity to meet with TN staff to work on academic activities, access interventions and effectively manage their own learning.

FlexTime activities are expected to support student's academics. These activities may include but are not limited to: make-up exams, test corrections, additional student support, designated quiet work time, essay writing, group work/collaboration time, individual work, and study hall.

When is Flex Time?

Flex Time will take place on Tuesdays & Thursdays. On these days, we will follow our flex time bell schedule.

Suggestions for what students may use FlexTime for:

- · Making up or starting homework
- · Getting help from a teacher

- Studying
- · Writing essays
- Talking to Counselors or the College/Career Counselors
- · Working on group projects

FlexTime is not a period for:

- Extended lunch
- · Socialization with friends
- · Hanging out
- Sleeping
- · Club meetings, ASB activities or sports practices

Where do students go during Flex Time?

Students must attend flex time with:

- · A current teacher in their schedule
- Library
- College & Career Center
- Counselor
- · Wellness Counselor
- School Social Worker

The Counseling Department is planning to use flex time to offer targeted support to students in such areas as mindfulness, positive coping strategies, time management, and various topics related to college and career exploration.

How does it work?

Students are expected to make an appointment using the TeachMore software for where they wish to spend their flex time. The Teachmore software is a web-based application and students can access it by using their school login information via their phone or a school device in the library, main office or the classroom.

Teachers may send an appointment request if they would like to work with a student. These appointments are mandatory. If a student receives multiple requests for the same day, the teachers and student will communicate.

Appointments must be made by lunch the day before flex. If an appointment is not made, students will be assigned a flextime location.

Students receive an email notification of the appointment and it will also appear when they log into TeachMore.

When students enter flex time, their attendance will be taken using their school id card through the TeachMore program. During flex time, students will not be allowed to meet with another teacher or go to another location. Hall passes and bathroom passes will be strongly discouraged.

Important Information to Know:

- Attendance is mandatory. Failure to attend will result in consequences.
- Flex Time Attendance will not be visible through Synergy. Administration will monitor attendance and communicate concerns with the student and parent/guardian.
- TN continues to be a closed campus during FlexTime.
- School rules and classroom behavior expectations still apply.

- Electronic devices should be used for academic purposes only and are at the discretion of the FlexTime staff member.
 - When electronic device use is permitted, the device should not be distracting to others.
- Teachers may designate flex days for specific activities. Students should pay attention to this information and make the appropriate choices for their learning needs.
- Violation of classroom expectations may result in discipline consequences.
- School computers and devices will be reserved for academic purposes only. Students will not be permitted to play games, update social media etc.
- Student signups will be monitored so that students cannot sign up for the same location the entire semester.

Students are able to login to PAPER using their school username/password at https://app.paper.co/login/student.

They will receive help within seconds in multiple subjects. Students can also submit any written work, including essays, lab reports, research papers or college application essays. Tutors provide detailed notes on grammar, structure and content. Work is even checked for missed citations or plagiarism.

They cost \$22. If you write a check, please make it out to Terra Nova High School


Sex Ed Squad!


