

Kindergarten District-Wide Assessment Quick Reference Guide 2024-25

This list includes assessments that are administered across the district. Additional tests may be administered on a school or student specific basis.

ELPA (English Language Proficiency)

ELPA21 measures proficiency in English based on four areas: reading, writing, speaking, and listening.

All students identified as English Language Learners (ELL) must take ELPA21, regardless of whether they have waived services. A score of "Proficient" can exit a student from the ELL program. Contact the Multilingual Department for more details.

The Alt-ELPA is an alternative form of the ELPA designed for ELL students experiencing significant cognitive disabilities. It may be administered in lieu of the ELPA assessment if it is specified in the student's IEP (Individualized Education Program).
