

Grade 1 District-Wide Assessment Quick Reference Guide 2024-25

This list includes assessments that are administered across the district. Additional tests may be administered on a school or student specific basis.

ELPA (English Language Proficiency)

ELPA21 measures proficiency in English based on four areas: reading, writing, speaking, and listening.

All students identified as English Language Learners (ELL) must take ELPA21, regardless of whether they have waived services. A score of "Proficient" can exit a student from the ELL program.

- Test window: January 21, 2025 – April 11, 2025
