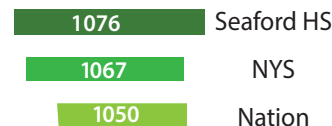

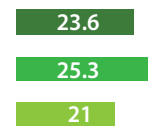

SAT Mean 2024

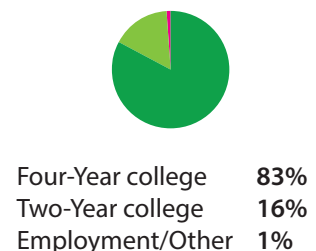
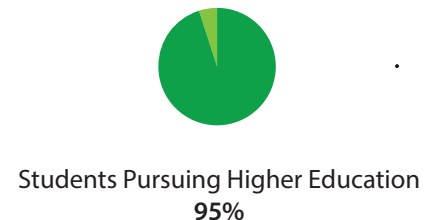
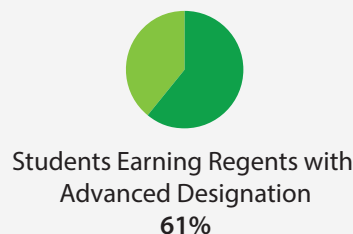
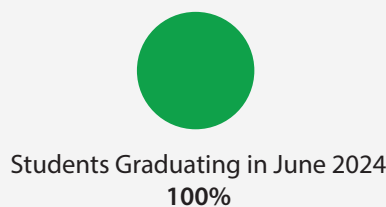
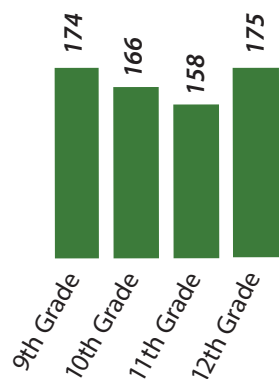


ACT Mean 2024

Final Grades & Weighted GPA

The final transcript grade is the actual unweighted average for the student earned for that course. Each course culminating in a numeric value will utilize the course system to determine the overall weighted GPA.

National Honor Society

Students who are selected for membership into the NHS have maintained a cumulative weighted grade point average of 91.5 percent or better, have participated a minimum of 40 hours in community service and have demonstrated qualities of leadership, strength in character and citizenship.

Interpretation of Course Terminology

Honors, Pre-Advanced Placement (Pre-AP), Advanced Placement (AP) & College Credit Courses:

Honors courses designed for students of superior academic ability. Academic requirements exceed Regents level course standards in depth of understanding and written requirements. Weighted: 1.10.

Regents (R): College preparatory level courses that follow the New York State learning standards. New York State Regents examinations are used as the final test in many (R) courses. Weighted: 1.00.

Science: All Honors, AP, and Regents Science courses such as Biology, Chemistry, Earth Science, Environmental Science and Physics have a required lab period as part of the course (double period every other day).

Denied Credit Due to Attendance (DCA): Student has excessive absences, which were not substantiated by medical or other documentation and credit for the course was denied.

Physical Education: All physical education courses are not factored into a students' overall GPA.
