

Students in 9th grade...

...will visit a college campus for the day! Each freshman student will tour a college campus with their classmates, SHS teachers, and counselors. <u>Permission slips</u> were distributed in "Counselor Connection" workshops on the first day of school and are due Friday, September 13.

- Regular morning bus pick-up/afternoon drop off will take place.
- Students will report to SHS at regular time and head to the auditorium.
- Regular return bus routes will be available.

Students in 10th or 11th grade...

...will take the in-school PSAT!

The school district has already registered and paid for your child to take this exam. The exam will be administered as a computer-based test using the "Bluebook" software. Mr. Mantay will work with all students in 10th and 11th grade to insure the software is installed on their device. We ask you to assist us with this by taking a moment to double-check your child's device. Return payment to Ms. DiMarco in the Guidance Office by Friday, September 13, 2024.

A \$65 payment must be made in full via cash, check or money order to "Seaford UFSD (Seaford Union Free School District)". Families are responsible for the cost of the exam. Families that are eligible for Free or Reduced Lunch may qualify for a discounted exam fee. If you have any concerns regarding payment, please contact Mr. Mantay. Unfortunately, if payment is not received by September 13, we will not be able to order the exam for the student.
