## TECH POLICY :

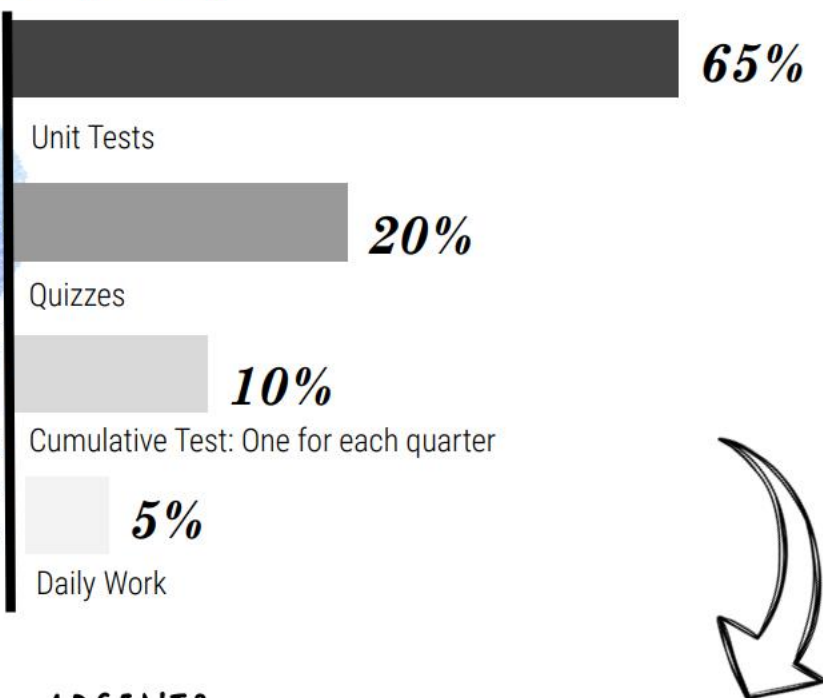
