CALENDAR & CLASSES

SCHOOL IS IN SESSION FOR 180 DAYS. THE CLASS PERIODS ARE APPROXIMATELY 52 MINUTES IN LENGTH. THE CREDIT EARNED IN EACH COURSE IS NOTED ON THE TRANSCRIPT. SEVEN FULL CREDIT CLASSES MEET EVERY DAY ALL YEAR EXCEPT FOR HEALTH/PE AND ECON/GOV WHICH ARE EACH ONE SEMESTER COURSES.

CURRICULUM

NORTHWEST WHITFIELD HIGH SCHOOL OFFERS COURSES AT VARIOUS DEGREES OF DIFFICULTY. STUDENTS ARE RECOMMENDED FOR THE VARIOUS LEVELS BASED UPON ABILITY, MOTIVATION BY TEACHERS AND THE SCHOOL COUNSELORS, BUT ULTIMATELY PARENTS MAY PLACE THEIR CHILDREN IN THE COURSES THEY DESIRE. STUDENTS MAY ALSO TAKE DE COURSES ON A COLLEGE CAMPUS IF THEY MEET ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS. OCCASIONALLY, STUDENTS MAY HAVE TROUBLE SCHEDULING ADVANCED CLASSES THAT ARE ONLY OFFERED ONE PERIOD AND CONFLICT WITH OTHER COURSE OFFERINGS.
