Frankfort-Schuyler CSD ATHLETIC EVENTS

The following will be enforced at all Frankfort-Schuyler CSD athletic events:

- All elementary and middle school students must be with a parent/guardian or an adult in order to attend sporting events. They are to stay with the adult during the entirety of the contest.
- There will be no balls, bikes, scooters, skateboards, pogo sticks, or pets allowed at any event.
- The board approved Frankfort-Schuyler CSD Code of Conduct applies during all extracurricular and athletic events.

Section III of the N.Y.S.P.H.S.A.A. Spectator Code of Behavior/Ethics:
