



## Classroom procedures:

- Late Work: Late assignments will be accepted ONE day late for HALF credit. Late work turned in more than one date late will not be eligible for credit.
  - ⇒ Penalties apply based on the type of assignment: Half credit for daily work and 10 points per day for labs
  - ⇒ Labs will not be accepted once the unit exam date has passed.



- Absence: <u>Students</u> are <u>Responsible</u> for picking up assignments for <u>all</u> absences.
  - ⇒ When absence is known in advance (school function, vacation, etc.) it is expected that students will complete all possible work prior to the absence.
  - ⇒ Length of time to complete work due to an absence will follow school policy.
