## Nonresident Schools of Choice Guidelines

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### **Application Procedure:**

All applications will be screened for accurate information. This may involve contacting a former or current school district.

Applications will be accepted online during a specific window of dates between March and August for the upcoming school year. Applications are also excepted in January for the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester of the current school year. See application for details. **Applications MAY NOT be received outside of these dates.** [School of Choice Application](#)

All applications **must** include: application form, behavior report for previous 2 (two) school years and the most recent report card. **ALL** high school applicants must provide a current transcript. **Behavior report and transcripts/report card are required to complete the application process.**

You will be notified via **email**, regarding the status of your application.

Students may be required to reapply annually for school of choice to remain in Garden City Public Schools.

### **Athletics:**

A secondary student-athlete enrolled through school of choice is not eligible to participate in interscholastic athletics for **one full semester** as defined and governed by the Michigan High School Athletic Association (MHSAA).

### **Attendance:**

Students are expected to arrive and depart from school on time and regularly attend school.

### **Code of Conduct:**

All students enrolled at Garden City Public Schools through school of choice are subject to the Student Code of Conduct. Copies are available at [Student Code of Conduct](#)

### **Transportation:**

Parents of school of choice students are expected to provide transportation to and from school. No transportation is provided for school of choice students.
