Dear Secondary Instrument Parent/Guardian:

As we look forward to the next school year, please be aware of the information below.

The Patchogue-Medford Music Department has an inventory of instruments at the Secondary level, but they are reserved for our incoming 4th graders. If there are any left over, they will be offered to interested students by lottery.

- Students at the secondary level need to continue to rent or purchase an instrument from an outside source. This includes violin, viola, cello, flute, clarinet, alto saxophone, trumpet, and trombone
- The school will continue to provide instruments only for students who play those that are unavailable for rental and beyond reasonable expectation to purchase, including: oboe, bassoon, bass clarinet, tenor sax, bari sax, baritone, tuba, and bass.

Instrument Rental – For those wishing to rent an instrument, we recommend finding the highest quality instrument possible from a reputable music store. Many stores offer “rent to own” plans, which can defray eventual purchase costs.

Instrument Purchase – For those wishing to purchase an instrument (not recommended until after at least the 2nd year of study), the list below contains instruments we recommend.

Violin/Viola – Bellafina Musicale Series (Must consult with music teacher for correct size)

Flute – Yamaha YFL-322, Yamaha YFL-222

Clarinet – Yamaha YCL-450N, Yamaha YCL-255

Alto Saxophone – Yamaha YAS-480, Yamaha YAS-26

Trumpet – Yamaha YTR-4335GII, Yamaha YTR-2330

Trombone – Yamaha YSL-446G, Yamaha YSL-354

General Supplies – Students will need the same basic supplies as this past year. Below is a list of updated reeds for woodwind players and a list of mouthpieces for band students we recommend all student purchase, regardless of if they rent or own an instrument. Teachers will inform their students if there are any updates to the lesson book needed.

Oboe – Leshner medium strength

Bassoon – Jones Medium

Clarinet – Vandoren 3 – Middle School
 D’Addario Reserve or Vandoren 3 – High School
 Bass Clarinet – Rico 3
 Saxophone – Vandoren 3
 Alto Saxophone – Vandoren 3 strength (new for 5th grade)

Recommended Mouthpieces for All Band Students – These mouthpieces will be used for many years. Please keep this in mind if you decide to purchase, as some of the mouthpieces will be in the range of \$60-\$150.

Clarinet – Vandoren M-30 Traditional
 Alto Saxophone – Selmer S80C
 Trumpet – Grades 5-8 – Bach 7c – 5c
 Grades 9-12 – Bach 5c-Bach 3c
 French Horn – Farkas MC
 Trombone/Baritone – Grades 4-8 –Bach 6 ½ AL
 Grades 9-12 – Schilke 51D
 Tuba – Grades 4-8 – Bach24AW
 Grades 9-12 – Bach 24AW to 18
