### **CI3T Purpose Statement:**

All of the New York Elementary School community, including administrators, faculty, staff, parents, and students, will collaborate to design, implement and evaluate a CI3T model to meet the academic, social, and behavioral needs of all students.

### WHAT IS A CI3T PLAN?

New York Elementary, along with all the elementary schools in the Lawrence Public School District, has implemented a Comprehensive Integrated Three–Tier model of prevention called CI3T. The program is data driven, proactive and will provide a safe and engaging learning environment for students.

CI3T utilizes a positive behavior system where students will be recognized when they are meeting the expectations outlined on the Code of Conduct found below. The main focus is on our three simple expectations:

- Be Respectful
- Be Responsible
- Be a Learner

Should a student need additional support to be successful, we will provide interventions in the area of need whether it is academic, social, or in following the expectation matrix.

We will provide more time for the student to learn the skill in a small group setting or through an individualized learning plan.
