3. SCHOOL DISTRICT HIGHLIGHTS: Ms. Badu highlighted the new TNTP National Report, "The Opportunity Makers," that is scheduled to be released on Wednesday, September 25. She attributed the school's success to having high learning expectations for all students while keeping them at the center of all conversations when making decisions. She said that she receives a lot of questions about what the school and the district are doing everywhere she goes to speak and to present. She said that the school's work is a celebration of high expectations, proving that schools across America can be successful with limited fiscal resources. Ms. Badru said that the school's successes are a "team" effort beginning with the Director of Schools who sets the vision and a Board that supports education. She stated that the school's teachers are vested in the work and have developed a successful partnership with parents over time. Ms. Badru explained that the elementary school was featured as one of only seven schools from 28,000 schools studied that grew students who entered school grade levels behind better than 95% of the schools in America. Ms. Badru concluded by saying that she is proud and humbled but emphasized that we still have room to improve. Mr. Kerr commended Ms. Badru and the elementary school for sending more and more students to the middle school who are on grade level, explaining how sending more students on grade level has a cascading effect across all grades and schools. Ms. Bode pointed out that Ms. Badru has been a constant for the school for over 10 years which is the exact duration of the TNTP study, noting that Ms. Badru has been instrumental in the school's success over the ten-year time period.

4. PRINCIPALS' REPORTS:

4.A. Trousdale County Elementary School – In addition to Ms. Badru's highlight report, she added that the school is presently averaging approximately (48) student absences per day. She stated that the absences are attributed to several illnesses that are going around. She stated that the school's current enrollment is (689) students which is approximately the same as it was in September of 2023.

4.B. Jim Satterfield Middle School – Mr. Gulley noted that we have completed (35) days of school and that the students and teachers are focused and working hard. He stated that student attendance has been strong and that the school is presently planning for benchmark assessments next week. He also stated that the school is presently preparing for Power Friday in-service that will be held on September 27. Mr. Gulley added that the school's training goals include analyzing TVAAS student projections and using the projections to set student learning goals for the school year.

4.C. Trousdale County High School – Mr. McCall stated that the first (35) days have been relatively smooth and that the transition to high school principal has been smooth as well. He informed the Board about the recent hiring of Ms. Holmes that is working as a half-time Nursing Education instructor. He stated that the high school is also preparing for benchmark assessments next week and that the new FAFSA application is opening up. Mr. McCall stated that the school's Power Friday focus would be learning how to analyze student data results from the benchmarks to inform instruction going forward. Mr. McCall also stated that he has moved the annual homecoming to the second week of October. He added that the school is

presently planning for the ACT Retake, the mock ACT and for Jostens's to meet with seniors about pictures and other graduation materials.

4.D. Student School Board Representatives – Student Representatives Elizabeth Denning and Hanna Tucker updated the Board about upcoming football and volleyball games and the most recent band competition held at Station Camp High. The representatives presented the Board with the new 2024-25 basketball schedule and discussed progress on the new senior parking lot painting opportunity, stating that it is very well received among seniors. They informed the Board that the FBLA will start a new coffee shop to be held only on Fridays.

5.B. Academic and Goal Updates – Dr. Satterfield informed the Board that present school district enrollment is at (1,382) students which is only (2) more than the same time last year. Dr. Satterfield informed the Board that the TN ALL Corps Tutoring program for designated 4th and 5th grade began on September 9, is led by Ms. Badru and is being taught by Ms. Ronna White and Mr. Caleb Schmittou. He stated that all new teachers (stage 1) have already

received (3) announced walkthrough observations including feedback conversations. He noted that this is a really good accomplishment by principals, their assistants, and instructional supervisors for this early in the school year. Dr. Satterfield reiterated the upcoming benchmark window of September 30 through October 4 with student report cards being sent home on October 15 and Parent-Teacher Conference scheduled for Thursday, October 17.

5.C. Project Updates – Dr. Satterfield stated that the elementary roof project is going well; however, the school experienced a lot of water intrusions over the weekend due to the heavy rains. He stated that the kindergarten and cafeteria areas have not been covered to date. Dr. Satterfield stated that the construction contract with FTM for the new field house has been signed and that he is presently awaiting site plan approval on October 14. Dr. Satterfield concluded by stating that the Board had receive a variance to renovate the restrooms at the football stadium.





1 The Director of Schools shall develop an administrative procedure to establish a system of grading and
 2 assessment for evaluating and recording student progress and to measure student performance in
 3 conjunction with board-adopted content standards for grades K-8. The grading/assessment system shall
 4 follow all applicable statutes and rules and regulations of the State Board of Education. The
 5 grading/assessment system shall be uniform, district-wide, at comparable grade levels, except that the
 6 Director of Schools shall have the authority to establish and operate ungraded and/or unstructured classes
 7 in grades K-3 according to state rules and regulations.¹

8 The Director of Schools shall submit a copy of the grading and assessment systems to the Board before
 9 the system is implemented. These guidelines shall be communicated annually to students and
 10 parent(s)/guardian(s).

11 Conduct grades are based on behavior and shall not be reflected in scholastic grades.

12 **GRADING SYSTEM: GRADES NINE - TWELVE (9-12)²**

13 Schools teaching grades nine (9) through twelve (12) shall use the uniform grading system established
 14 by the State Board of Education. Using the uniform grading system, students' grades shall be reported
 15 for the purposes of application for post-secondary financial assistance administered by the Tennessee
 16 Student Assistance Corporation.

17 Subject-area grades shall be expressed by the following letters with their corresponding percentage
 18 range:

- 19 • A (90-100)
- 20 • B (80-89)
- 21 • C (70-79)
- 22 • D (60-69)
- 23 • F (0-59)

24 Grading floors with a minimum above zero are not permitted.³ This grading system shall be uniform
 25 throughout the school district for each grade.

28 This grading system shall be uniform throughout the school district for grades 3-12. Academic
 29 progress for grades K-2 in Reading and Mathematics shall be Standards Based and expressed by the
 30 following descriptors:
