Ages & Stages Questionnaire (ASQ)

The Ages & Stages Questionnaire (ASQ) was sent home October 9 for all 3 & 5-Day students, and October 10 for 2-Day students. The ASQ is a developmental and social-emotional screening for children between the ages of 2 and 6 that is completed by the parent/guardian. This tool is designed to pinpoint developmental progress and catch delays in young children, paving the way for meaningful next steps in learning, intervention, or monitoring. Please complete the ASQ and return it to your child's teacher no later than TOMORROW, Friday, October 18.

Sensory Screenings Are October 21 (Must opt in)

Southern California Sensory Screening will be here Monday, October 21, to provide Preschool Health Assessments for Preschool and Pre-K children, ages 3 and older. Tests include hearing screening, vision screening, speech/language screening, and gross/fine motor screening. Permission slips to opt in were sent home at the beginning of the week.
