PEER *Mediators*

In November 2023, nearly 300 students in grades 3-12 were sworn in as peer mediators, marking a significant move toward positive conflict resolution in schools. These students completed training in conflict resolution and mediation skills to help their peers resolve minor conflicts.



STUDENT *Voice*

Student Voice, a District initiative led by Superintendent Dr. Wayne N. Walters, empowers young people to become leaders in their communities. Students have organized the annual student voice conference, a mental health fair, and influenced the use of federal funds in their schools.

STUDENT ENVOY *Project*

The Student Envoy Project empowers students as active partners in enhancing academic performance and school culture. Trained Student Envoys lead cultural change among their peers throughout their schools.
