OUR DIRECTOR - Mr. Thomas Eyster

Thomas Eyster is in his 28th year as director of instrumental music at West York Area High School. He is also the Instructional Leader for the Music Department for the West York Area School District. During his tenure at West York, the symphonic band has received numerous superior ratings at state and national adjudications and have been a featured performing ensemble for the PMEA State Conferences several times. Prior to "coming home" to West York, Mr. Eyster taught in the Upper Darby School District in Delaware County, Pennsylvania.

A graduate of West York, Mr. Eyster received his B.M. Degree in Music Education from Susquehanna University and has done additional study in music education and conducting at Peabody Conservatory of Music and Duquense University and Loyola College of Maryland.

In addition to his duties at West York, Mr. Eyster has served as an adjudicator, clinician, and guest conductor in Pennsylvania and Maryland. He also serves as director of the concert band for Music Ambassadors Abroad and served as associate music director for the Pennsylvania Ambassadors of Music concert band for their bi-annual European concert tours. Mr. Eyster was also an assistant director of the York All-County Band formed for the City of York's 250th Anniversary. In 1989, he was awarded a "Citation of Excellence" by the National Band Association for outstanding contributions to concert bands and band music. Mr. Eyster is also listed in the 1998 edition of "Who's Who Among America Teachers".

Mr. Eyster is a member of the P.S.E.A. and N.E.A., the National Band Association, International Association of Jazz Educators, Pennsylvania Music Educators Association, and the Music Educators National Conference. Other societies to his credit include life memberships to Phi Mu Alpha (professional music fraternity), Phi Beta Mu (national bandmaster fraternity) and Phi Sigma Kappa (national social fraternity).

ABOUT THE BAND

The West York Area High School Band begins each year with two weeks of intensive music and marching rehearsals. The first week for new members is "Rookie Week", followed by "Band Camp" which was held this August at Camp Ramblewood in Darlington, Maryland.

During the fall, the band performs at home and away football games and for numerous school and civic occasions. Often featured are the majorettes, coached by Wanda Reider, the "A-Line" coached by Mrs. Gwen Shaffer, and the all-male Bulldog Colorguard.

The Symphonic Band is offered as an elective curricular subject meeting three periods per week for full academic credit, and performs 3 major concerts each year.. In addition, many students participate in solo work and small ensembles meeting after school and evenings.

In addition to concerts presented in the York area, the band also travels occasionally and has performed throughout Pennsylvania and many other states and Canada. Ensembles have performed at clinics and/or concerts at many Pennsylvania colleges, the PMEA State Convention, on television, the State Capitol in Harrisburg, and for numerous civic and church organizations in the area. Highlighting the band's past activities are performances in Mexico City (1972). Disney World (1974 & 1979), Nashville, Tennessee (1983), Toronto, Canada (1982, 1990 & 1996), Boston, Massachusetts (1984 & 1988), and Bermuda (1992). The band has also performed at the Mid-East Band Clinic in Pittsburgh, the Eastern Band Conductors Conference and has twice been selected to perform for the Pennsylvania Music Educators Association State Conference (1982 & 1989). In 1998, the band traveled to Toronto, Canada and participated in the Toronto "Festivals of Music" where they were awarded the "William D. Revelli Outstanding Concert Band" award for the most outstanding band in the festival. In 2000, the band traveled to the Cedar Point Music Festival in Ohio where they earned a superior rating. In 2003, the band toured Orlando, Sarasota, Naples, and Miami, Florida.

BAND STUDENT GOVERNMENT

Because of increasing size and complexity of the total band program, a need was felt for more student control and committee work. Thus, in January, 1960, a system of student government was adopted.

Each officer and staff member has assigned duties and obligations which he/she must perform in order for the band to function smoothly. In addition, the Executive Council meets at irregular intervals to discuss band policy, plan social activities and work on student committees.

Major projects developed by the council in the past include: the promotion of band jackets and shirts, the adoption of award pins, certificates and letters, and planning of certain phases of the band camps.

Tonight the symphonic band will be playing a varied selection of pieces and I hope you will sit back, relax, and enjoy the performance.



It has been a great year for all of those involved in West York's Band Program and we should all be proud of what has been accomplished.
























2004 MIGHTY BULLDOG MARCHING BAND
