



#### **About The Band**

The West York Area High School Band begins each year with a week of intensive music and marching rehearsals during their annual "Band Camp" which was held this August at Camp Ramblewood in Darlington, Maryland.

During the fall, the band performs at home and away football games and for numerous school and civic occasions. Often featured is the band front, coached by Mrs. Wanda Salisbury, Mrs. Gwen Shaffer, and Ms. Katie Sweeney.

The Symphonic Band is offered as an elective curricular subject meeting three periods per week for full academic credit, and performs 3 major concerts each year. In addition, many students participate in solo work and small ensembles meeting after school and evenings. The most active and popular ensemble is the Jazz Ensemble which performs approximately 10 times throughout the school year.

In addition to concerts presented in the York area, the band also travels occasionally and has performed throughout Pennsylvania and many other states and Canada. Ensembles have performed at clinics and/or concerts at many Pennsylvania colleges, the PMEA State Convention, on television, the State Capitol in Harrisburg, and for numerous civic and church organizations in the area. Highlighting the band's past activities are performances in Mexico City (1972), Disney World (1974 & 1979), Nashville, Tennessee (1983), Toronto, Canada (1982, 1990 & 1996), Boston, Massachusetts (1984 & 1988), and Bermuda (1992). The band has also performed at the Mid-East Band Clinic in Pittsburgh, the Eastern Band Conductors Conference and has twice been selected to perform for the Pennsylvania Music Educators Association State Conference (1982 & 1989). In 1998, the band traveled to Toronto, Canada and participated in the Toronto "Festivals of Music" where they were awarded the "William D. Revelli Outstanding Concert Band" award for the most outstanding band in the festival. In 2000, the band traveled to the Cedar Point Music Festival in Ohio where they earned a superior rating. In 2003, the band toured Orlando, Sarasota, Naples, and Miami, Florida. The band took a concert tour to Virginia Beach in the spring of 2007.

# Our Director - Mr. Thomas Eyster

Thomas Eyster is in his 34th year as director of instrumental music at West York Area High School. He is also the Instructional Leader for the Music Department for the West York Area School District. During his tenure at West York, the symphonic band has received numerous superior ratings at state and national adjudications and have been a featured performing ensemble for the PMEA State Conferences several times. Prior to "coming home" to West York, Mr. Eyster taught for one year in the Upper Darby School District in Delaware County, Pennsylvania.

A graduate of West York, Mr. Eyster received his B.M. Degree in Music Education from Susquehanna University and has done additional study in music education and conducting at Peabody Conservatory of Music and Duquense University and Loyola College of Maryland.



In addition to his duties at West York, Mr. Eyster has served as an adjudicator, clinician, and guest conductor in Pennsylvania and Maryland. He also serves as director of the concert band and jazz ensemble for Youth Music Abroad for their bi-annual European concert tours. He also has served as associate music director for the Pennsylvania Ambassadors of Music concert band. For the past 15 years, he has served as music director/advisor for the York County Junior Miss program. Mr. Eyster was also an assistant director of the York All-County Band formed for the City of York's 250th Anniversary. In 1989, he was awarded a "Citation of Excellence" by the National Band Association for outstanding contributions to concert bands and band music. Mr. Eyster is also listed in several editions of "Who's Who Among America Teachers". He is also the recipient of several awards from the Veterans of Foreign Wars and serveral civic organizations.

Mr. Eyster is a member of the P.S.E.A. and N.E.A., the National Band Association, International Association of Educators, Pennsylvania Music Educators Association, and the Music Educators National Conference. Other exists to his credit include life memberships to Phi Mu Alpha (professional music fraternity), Phi Beta Mu (nadal bandmaster fraternity) and Phi Sigma Kappa (national social fraternity).





#### The Year in Review 2010-2011

Following the annual tradition at the high school, this year it was the band's turn to play Leroy Anderson's "Sleigh Ride". The band also played Celtic Carol, and various other heartwarming pieces. Additionally, the jazz band performed their sixth annual holiday jazz concert.




























#### Albert Kelly Memorial Summer Camp Scholarship


