

# **ABOUT THE BAND**

The West York Area High School Band begins each year with a week of intensive music and marching resals during their annual "Band Camp" which was held this August at Camp Ramblewood in Darlington, had land.

ing the fall, the band performs at home and away football games and for numerous school and civic ocis. Often featured is the band front coached by Mrs. Gwen Shaffer and Mrs. Katie Nagel.

Symphonic Band is offered as an elective curricular subject meeting three periods per week for full acades a credit, and performs 3 major concerts each year. In addition, many students participate in solo work and small ensembles meeting after school and evenings. The most active and popular ensemble is the Jazz Ensemble which performs approximately 10 times throughout the school year.

In addition to concerts presented in the York area, the band also travels occasionally and has performed throughout Pennsylvania and many other states and Canada. Ensembles have performed at clinics and/or concerts at many Pennsylvania colleges, the PMEA State Convention, on television, the State Capitol in Harrisburg, and for numerous civic and church organizations in the area. Highlighting the band's past activities are performances in Mexico City (1972), Disney World (1974 & 1979), Nashville, Tennessee (1983), Toronto, Canada (1982, 1990 & 1996), Boston, Massachusetts (1984 & 1988), and Bermuda (1992). The band has also performed at the Mid-East Band Clinic in Pittsburgh, the Eastern Band Conductors Conference and has twice been selected to perform for the Pennsylvania Music Educators Association State Conference (1982 & 1989). In 1998, the band traveled to Toronto, Canada and participated in the Toronto "Festivals of Music" where they were awarded the "William D. Revelli Outstanding Concert Band" award for the most outstanding band in the festival. In 2000, the band traveled to the Cedar Point Music Festival in Ohio where they earned a superior rating. In 2003, the band toured Orlando, Sarasota, Naples, and Miami, Florida. The band took a concert tour to Virginia Beach in the spring of 2007.



He is a member of the adjunct faculty of York College where he teaches applied percussion. Mr. Meckley has also taught private percussion lessons.



Born and raised in York County, Mr. Meckley is a graduate of William Penn Senior High School. He received his Bachelor of Science Degree in Music Education from West Chester University, and his Masters of Science Degree in Music Education from Towson University.

Mr. Meckley has been a guest speaker on urban music education at Millersville University. He has a long history with the Drum and Bugle Corps activity. Mr. Meckley marched for four years with the award winning Garfield Cadets Drum and Bugle Corps. Following his participation as a member, he then went on to become a percussion instructor for Dutch Boy Drum and Bugle Corps in Kitchener Ontario, and has served as a percussion judge for Drum Corps International competitions.

Mr. Meckley is a member of the Pennsylvania Music Educator's Association, the National Association for Music Education and the Jazz Education Network. He enjoys sharing his knowledge and his love of music with all of his students, and is still active in performing as a percussionist and trombonist.





# THE YEAR IN REVIEW 2015-2016

As the year draws to a close, you may hear a sound: the sounds of seniors saying goodbye to the place they made their home for the past four years. The seniors will begin their journey through college soon, with many new and exciting things to look forward too. Unfortunately for them, nothing will be as exciting as their four years spent with the band.

Collectively, the bands have prepared music through dozens of hours of work. The marching band started the season in July, when we embarked to Camp Ramblewood for another band camp. Lead by the cheery drum major Katie Tallman, the marching band grinded hours of practice out each day to put together the field show, "The Power of Love", where we performed the songs "Gimme Some Lovin", "Radar Love", "Love Shack", "Love Runs Out", and "When a Man Loves a Woman". Ironically, we did not play the song "The Power of Love". The marching band was also able to perform their show at the Dover Band Show and the York Fair Expo. Unfortunately, both the Red Lion Sound Spectacular and band night were cancelled due to weather.

Symphonic Band was right around the corner, and began practicing for their first concert, the Holiday Concert, shortly after school began. As usual, the band performed festive pieces to get everyone into the holiday mood. Unfortunately for band parents, their kids began singing holiday tunes months before the actual holiday season. This year, the symphonic band was able to take part in something special. Dr. James Colonna from York College of Pennsylvania composed a piece for the West York bands in celebration of Marlene Eyster's life. Marlene was the wife of previous band director, Thomas Eyster. Our band was the first band to play this piece, and it was debuted at the Winter Festival of Winds. The piece called for all levels of musicianship to play alongside the Elementary and Middle School bands. To accompany the size of the band, we performed the concert in the newly constructed gym. The last concert of the year, being performed today, has a primarily patriotic theme, which was demonstrated through tunes such as "Concord", and "America Forever".

The Jazz band performed at the holiday concert, playing renditions of everyone's favorite holiday songs, and they performed shortly at the Winter Festival of Winds. The Jazz band also performed their annual Jazz Night concert. The Jazz band also had the opportunity to play for Distinguished Young Women, a local scholarship competition for high school juniors to demonstrate their academic abilities, achievements in life, and future aspirations. Lastly, they took their talents to Cherry Lane to perform songs from their Jazz Night concert in Downtown York.

The Pit Orchestra performed the music for this year's musical, "Shrek: The Musical", and Mr. Meckley gave the pit the apt name of "The Swamp". The swamp followed Shrek, an ogre, through his journey to find true love. A member of The Swamp, Diane Sutyak, was selected to play with the PMEA's All-State Orchestra, after a rigorous audition process that included playing in both the District and Regional Orchestras. Two other members of the Swamp, Allison Ruman and Nicholas Hutton, were members of the PMEA District 7 Band. Lastly, Allison Ruman, Emily Kurtz, Nicholas Hutton, Kira Spangler, Diane Sutyak, Ashleigh Cummings, and Rebecca Eyler played their instruments in the York County Honors Band festival.
