

Homework Clinic 2021-2022



Homework Clinic is available each Monday, Tuesday and Thursday from 3-4 pm. It will be held in room 212. Students may attend Homework Clinic if they have their parent's permission to stay after school AND have transportation home (or permission to walk home) at 4 pm. **Students must bring ALL their class materials and their independent reading book.** Teachers will be available to answer questions. Students may come to the homework clinic voluntarily, or a teacher may assign students to attend.

Homework clinic is for quiet, independent school work. It is not for socializing, listening to music or playing games on chrome books. All students will be logged into Lanschool during the clinic and the same rules for school behavior and use of technology apply during this time. Use of phones will be limited to after 4 pm. Students and parents will sign below that they have read and understand the rules of Homework Clinic. **Students must be picked up at the school by 4:15 pm at the latest. Students not adhering to any of the above rules will be unable to attend further Homework Clinic days.**
