Dear Parents and Guardians,

On behalf of our outstanding faculty and staff, we'd like to invite you to attend our schoolwide (Pre-K through 8th grade) Halloween Parade on **Thursday, October 31st starting at 1:00pm**. 
Influenza Vaccine

Requirement Reminder



The current seasonal influenza vaccine is required every year for those children 6 months of age through 4 years and 11 months of age attending preschool. **Students who have not received the flu vaccine by December 31st must be excluded** (not allowed to attend preschool) for the duration of the influenza season (through March 31) until they receive at least one dose of the influenza vaccine or until they turn 5 years old. Please **provide proof of immunization by December 23rd, 2024** in order to ensure your child may attend when we return to school on January 2, 2024. 
