Reflections From Our Pastor

My Dear St. Agnes Family,

In Catholicism, brothers begin their first stage of formation with the novitiate, which is a period of training and discernment that happens before a person takes their initial religious vows, allowing them to decide if they are called to a life in the religious order.

The next important step in their process is the "first profession of vows." For brothers, it refers to the initial commitment a man makes to live a life dedicated to the Church by taking the vows of poverty, chastity, and obedience. It signifies their dedication to a life of service within a religious order as a brother.

Ultimately, it is the first time they formally pledge to live according to these vows within their community and marks the brothers' full commitment to their chosen religious order.

I want to personally invite all of you to join our brothers as they take their First Profession of Vows on Oct. 22nd, 2024 at 7PM at Our Lady of Guadalupe Catholic Church. Our own St. Agnes Brother Zachary will now become Brother Peter Michael of the Heart of the Divine Child, SCTJM.



Ballot Summary

No law shall prohibit, penalize, delay, or restrict abortion before viability or when necessary to protect the patient's health, as determined by the patient's healthcare provider. This amendment does not change the Legislature's constitutional authority to require notification to a parent or guardian before a minor has an abortion.

Viability is not defined, and will include painful, late-term abortions through birth.

No definition for healthcare provider is given, leading to non-physicians performing abortions.

parental notificatin is NOT parental consent, allowing underage children to obtain abortions without their parents' permission.




The 2024 election season is upon us and faithful citizens can use this time to form their consciences, learn about the issues, and research the candidates as they prepare to cast their ballots. The following resources are offered by the Florida Conference of Catholic Bishops (FCCB) to assist in this endeavor. The USCCB offers this teaching document to guide Catholics in the exercise of their rights and duties as participants in our democracy. Pastors, lay and religious faithful, and all people of good are urged to use this statement to help form their consciences; to teach those entrusted to their care; to contribute to civil and respectful public dialogue; and to shape political choices in the coming election in light of Catholic teaching.



Before voting, Catholics are called to consider a wide range of issues, weighing each according to its moral significance. Gaining familiarity with the candidates' positions on issues involving human life and dignity is essential to responsible, faithful citizenship. It is beneficial to research the ballot ahead of time and gather the facts for every proposal and race. The FCCB Voter Guide provides information about Catholic teaching, offers considerations on key topics, and poses questions regarding current issues to assist voters in evaluating candidate positions or political party platforms.



In keeping with its mission, the FCCB aims to educate and inform Catholics about a wide range of issues. The FCCB has developed a comparison between the positions candidates for United States Kamala Harris (Democrat) and Donald Trump (Republican), on multiple topics. The positions of the candidates have been compiled directly from policies, public statements, official or campaign websites, and other sources, as of September 6, 2024. The FCCB is nonpartisan and does not support or oppose candidates.


