

Requirements:

- Do not cut the head/hairline at the top of the photo.
- Only head and shoulders will be in the yearbook photo (some cropping may occur).
- · No special filters or graphics added to the photograph.
- If hands are near the face, there should be no hand gestures.
 Photos with hand gestures will be rejected.
- BE SURE THAT YOU HAVE NOT CLICKED "DO NOT PUBLISH" on Skyward to ensure your photo will be in the book.
- The FHS Yearbook staff reserve the right to refuse any photograph.
- There will not be an email notification confirming the submission. If your portrait has been approved, you will see a date by your student ID number on a spreadsheet that will be sent out.

You're a senior now and you have the opportunity to submit your own senior photo! If you do not submit a photo, your school photo will be used.

You will upload your photo to the yearbook website. No email submissions will be accepted.

Before you start:

- 1.Make sure photo is the correct size/format. Your photographer should provide you with the correct size image. Give them the requirements showed in the picture on the left--(2.5 x3.5, 300 dpi)
- 2. Don't take an image off social media or a phone. Why?

 Because if you copy images from the internet or a phone, the quality of the photo declines. If this happens, the photo will not be approved and your school photo will be used instead. Use the photograph directly from your photographer.

Apprenticeship & Internship Programs

Apprenticeships

- 1-2 years, learn specific trade skills, compensated, earn a certificate/license in the field, high chance of immediate employment
- Careers: Building, Construction, Manufacturing, Machine, IT, Healthcare, Service, Body Art, and Support
- Typically, 18+ with HS Degree/GED

<u>Internships</u>

- Temporary or seasonal (3-6 months), help you learn more about a general industry role or company, typically not compensated
- Careers: Marketing/Sales, Finance, Communications, HR, Social Work, Sports Med
- Typically 16+

Military

- ► US Air Force
- >US Navy
- ► US Army
- US Marines Corps
- US Coast Guard
- National Guard
 - Representatives will be visiting throughout the year
 - Visit the Career Center to see who is coming when.

Community & Tech College

- WHY?
 - Financially more accessible
 - Specific training / certification
 - 2-year programs
 - Smaller class sizes
 - Local options
 - Can be used to start 4-Year Degree!
 - OPEN ACCESS & ROLLING ENROLLMENT



Community & Tech College

- One application to apply to all!
 https://apply.ctc.edu/user
- Some have application fees
- If you are enrolled in Running Start, you will need to re-apply as a college student

WHY?

- More advanced degree options
- Campus Life
- WAGAP

Things to Consider:

- Apply to 3-5 colleges (reach, target, safety)
- Location/size (Urban? Rural? Community Demographics?)
- Educational Programs (do they offer your major/interest?).
- Athletics
- Private vs Public
- Religious Affiliations
- Academic Fit (GPA/test scores)
- Cost!

Princeton Review College Search

Reach

- Academically challenging you may not quite fit the college's academic profile
- Selective admissions
- Potentially high cost of attendance

Target

- Likely to be admitted based on your academic profile
- You would be happy attending that college
- Would not be financially overwhelming to attend

Safety

- You are almost certain to be admitted
- You would be happy and get a good education there
- Affordable with reasonable effort

College Admissions 2025

College Admissions Counselors will use a holistic review of your high school career, including GPA, course rigor, extra curricular activities, and community engagement! (It's not all about grades!)



4 Year College Applications

- College Website
 - Create user account



- Common Application
 - Open an account at: https://commonapp.org
 - O Check for specific supplements
- If you need admissions fee waiver, ask your counselor
- CHECK DEADLINES!

College Application Essay

- > Varies by college, so be sure to check their website
- ➤ Write to the prompt: Be honest, be yourself, share your unique story. You are special! ☺
- > Draft, Draft, Redraft
- Have outside sources proofread for you (teacher, counselor, parent/guardian, mentor, etc.)





Letters of Recommendation

- Varies by college! Check website or Common App to see if your specific schools require any letters or rec
- Complete a 'Request for Letter of Recommendation Form'
 - Available on Counselor's Corner Canvas Page
- Think about who can best write about your academic journey, activities, and abilities. Give form to each recommender.
 - O Provide a minimum of 3 weeks to write the letter!
- For the Common App:
 - Invite two teachers to write letters.
 - Invite counselor to complete student recommendation
 - Ask before you send them an email invitation!

College Entrance Exams

- All Washington State Public Colleges (and most Independent colleges) are **test-optional or test-blind**
- SAT

Reasoning Assessment (Critical Reading, Math & Writing)

►ACT

Curriculum Based (English, Math, Reading & Science)

Scores: Must be sent directly from the ACT/SAT websites at time of registration.

Fee waivers available. Ask your counselor!

Better FAFSA/WAFSA 2024

More eligibility

- Larger average Pell awards.
- More students eligible for Pell.
- Expected Family Contribution (EFC) is now Student Aid Index (SAI), which more accurately reflects students' costs and financial need.

Simpler application

- Fewer questions on form.
- People only see and respond to questions for their specific role (e.g., student, parent).
- With direct connection to IRS, families don't need to enter income info manually. (Note, tax filing not required to submit a FAFSA application.)

Adjusted timeline

- 2024-25 application opening delayed until December 2023.
- Check with your college to see if other deadlines are impacted (admissions applications, scholarships).

What about WASFA?

- The Washington Application for State Financial Aid (WASFA) will open at the same time as the FAFSA.
- The WASFA is also improving, with fewer questions and a simpler form.
- Complete only one application: FAFSA or WASFA. Most people should file a FAFSA to maximize financial aid.
- The WASFA is for people who are undocumented or who do not qualify for federal financial aid, and may be used by others in limited circumstances.
