Parent Connect and Quarterly Encore Grades...

The end of the 1st quarter will be on November 1st and our students will start their new quarterly Encore class on Monday November 4th. We will not be distributing separate report cards for quarterly Encore grades but we will be posting student Encore grades on Parent Connect and they will be viewable after November 15th.

Trimester #1 Report Cards...

Trimester report cards will be coming home with students on December 13th. As always, please sign the report card envelope and have your student return it to their homeroom teacher. This we will also be including results from the first NWEA Assessment of this year. The information we get about students on the NWEA- it is a growth measure tool and we will be administering it one more time in March. Information will be included in your child's report card about understanding and interpreting their results.


We have had great success in keeping Maltby a distraction-free learning environment by following these procedures. In addition, we ask that parents please refrain from calling or texting their student during the school day.
