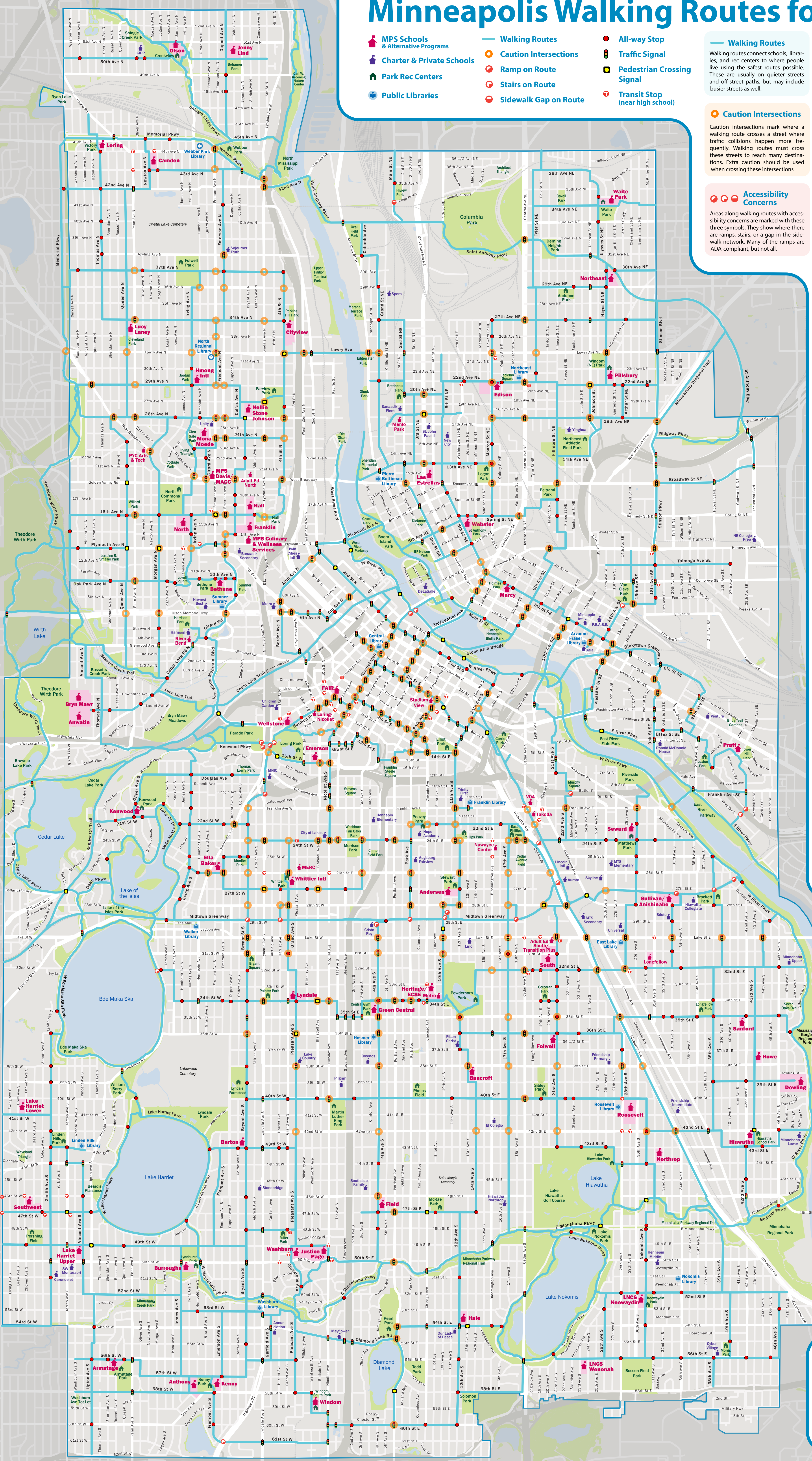
Walking Routes
Walking routes connect schools, libraries, and rec centers to where people live using the safest routes possible. These are usually on quieter streets and off-street paths, but may include busier streets as well.

Caution Intersections
Caution intersections mark where a walking route crosses a street where traffic collisions happen more frequently. Walking routes must cross these streets to reach many destinations. Extra caution should be used when crossing these intersections.

Accessibility Concerns
Areas along walking routes with accessibility concerns are marked with these three symbols. They show where there are ramps, stairs, or a gap in the sidewalk network. Many of the ramps are ADA-compliant, but not all.
