The CrisisGo app is free to download by following the steps outlined in [this link](#). In addition, please encourage your children to download the [Safe2SpeakUp](#) app from the Apple Store or Google Play. They can sign in using Single Sign On (SSO) using their Google credentials. This will allow your child to receive alerts during a drill or real emergency along with important directions for safety in the event of a real emergency.
