



Delaware parents and students interested in exploring school options for the 2025-2026 school year are invited to attend our Annual School Choice Information Meeting.

SCHOOL CHOICE APPLICATION WINDOW:

November 4, 2024 - January 8, 2025

APPLYING

Due to the district reorganization in 2025, all Kindergarten through Fifth Grade (K-5) "School Choice" students in Milford School District <u>must</u> reapply.

If you've completed your current program, even if previously accepted, you need to submit a new application. This also applies if you are moving from:

• Elementary to Milford Central Academy, or Milford Central Academy to Milford High School

WHAT IS SCHOOL CHOICE?

In DE, the school choice program gives families the flexibility to choose the public school that best meets their child's needs, providing space exists.

Delaware residents with school-age children can apply to go to any public school in the state regardless of district in which they reside. Only Delaware residents may apply for this program.

TRANSPORTATION

Parent/Family is responsible for transporting students to the school of choice
