What does the Annual Fund do?



Annual giving provides critical resources for that portion of the budget not covered by tuition dollars. Tuition falls short of the true cost of an SPA education, covering 83 percent. Philanthropy, including gifts to the Annual Fund, helps to close that gap.

### Together for SPA Margin of Excellence

Philanthropic support from SPA parents, alumni/ae, grandparents, faculty, staff, and friends of the school makes up most of the difference between what tuition covers and the actual cost of educating each student.

# The difference is \$6,500 per student.

That margin of excellence is what makes our school exceptional. It's how we do the many things that make our programs stand out, such as the enormous breadth and depth of courses in the Upper School, the two teachers in every homeroom in the Lower School, and sending the entire seventh grade to Camp Widjiwagan every year.
