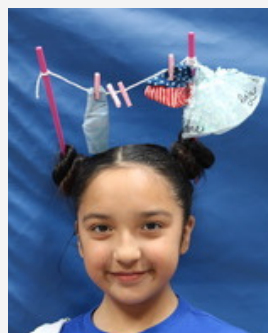
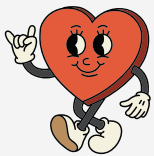
WALK-A-THON
