- ✓ **Annual Parent Meeting**

Tarver-Rendon Elementary School of Agriculture Leadership will hold an annual fall meeting for all parents of enrolled children. Parents will be notified of the meeting through a notice sent home with students, the school website, and the school marquee. At the annual Title I meeting Tarver-Rendon will present general information about its Title I programs, curriculum, instruction, and various forms of assessment used to measure student progress. Parents will also be given information about the school's programs, and specific curriculum information in the core content areas. Additionally, Tarver-Rendon will work to provide flexible meeting times for our annual Title I update and to provide information about curriculum and state assessments. Parents will receive information about how-to schedule parent conferences, intervention opportunities, and opportunities to become involved in campus activities.
