Student Post Graduation Plans

Are Arlington Students Ready for College?

Through collaborative research with postsecondary institutions nationwide, ACT has established the following as college readiness benchmark scores for designated college courses.

A benchmark score is the minimum score needed on an ACT subject-area test to indicate a 50% chance of obtaining a B or higher or about a 75% chance of obtaining a C or higher in the corresponding credit-bearing college courses. These scores were empirically derived based on the actual performance of students in college.

- English Composition: 18 on ACT English Test
- Algebra: 22 on ACT Mathematics Test
- Social Sciences: 22 on ACT Reading Test
- Biology: 23 on ACT Science Test
