



Denison High School Career Investigation Day Form



State Law permits a student, classified as a junior or senior, from attending school for a career investigation day to visit a professional at the professional's workplace during the student's junior and senior years of high school to determine the student's interest in pursuing a career in the professional's field. The student may not be excused for more than a total of two (2) days each year for this purpose.

The law requires a verification of the student's Career Investigation Day to the professional's workplace. This form must be completed, signed, and dated by an appropriate official from the professional's workplace visited by the student. The completed form must be submitted to the student's high school upon return to classes following the visit. Incomplete forms, including the dates of the visitation or the signature of the appropriate official from the professional's workplace will result in the student being unexcused for the days of the visitation.
