Welcome back Vikings!

The Oakmont Health Careers Academy is continuing to refine its program and is excited to share that two of its classes will now be offering college credit to its students through a partnership with Sierra College!

Our current Sophomore class is enrolled in Medical Terminology (HSCI 0003) and will earn 3 college credits that are UC/CSU transferable, giving them a head start as they continue their education.

The Junior class that is taking DE Health Careers will also be enrolled in Introduction to Allied Health (ALH 0020), a 1 credit course that will familiarize them with healthcare professions, their current trends, and give students a roadmap of education to complete while pursuing a career in the growing field of healthcare.

The Junior class will also be embarking on our annual college tour in November (11/14-15) where they will connect with college admissions staff, program coordinators, and Health Academy alumni who are actively involved in nursing and healthcare degree programs. 




Cell Phone Policy
