Spanish II Goals

Spanish II is a continuation of Spanish I. During second semester, we will continue talking about ourselves, our families and our friends but we will ADD the ability to talk in the past. You will be able to discuss shopping, vacations (present & past), volunteer service and movie preferences. We will keep talking and writing about our present, plans for the future and adding past events.

We will work with those objectives which correlate to the ND Standards and Benchmarks. The proficiency goals for Spanish II are in the Novice High range with some students starting to dabble in the Intermediate standards. Spanish III and IV standards are in the intermediate level. The lowest defined level of biliteracy is when a student reaches the intermediate level in all standards and modalities (reading, writing, speaking, listening). **Expectations:**

Students will be held accountable for PACKER PRIDE, the CCR (Collaboration, Compassion & Responsibility matrix and classroom expectations.

- 1. Instructor and students will gain knowledge as the year progresses.
- 2. Instructor and students acknowledge that we are human and mistakes will happen.
- 3. Instructor acknowledges that every student is unique, has a unique situation and deserves to be treated as such.
- 4. Students acknowledge that they will be treated individually and uniquely in all situations.

Communication

I am constantly close to technology. The BEST way to get immediate feedback or to ask a question would be an **email or Schoology message**. My work email is <u>walker@west-fargo.k12.nd.us</u>. The email can even request a phone call. I do check my email at home so I most likely would even respond before the next class period.

Schoology is a tool that will give students reminders and access to notes as well as ask questions to me or others in the class.

My goal is to send home an email/video update at least once a quarter.

My lesson plans are posted in weekly folders in Schoology on the first day of the school week in our weekly folder. I also post examples, links for review, websites, and most PowerPoints on the calendars or I will share them with you through Schoology class documents. Please check there often! The lesson plan may change throughout the week. However, all changes are visible in the weekly PowerPoint.

Grades will be calculated and updated on PowerSchool every Friday morning. Any late work may take up to 5 days to be graded and inputted into PowerSchool.

Grades are based on a total points system. Homework and daily work is worth between 1-5 points. Quizzes, special assignments, and projects are worth between 10-40 points. Chapter assessments are worth 50-85 points. Extra credit may occasionally be offered. Usually is it only 1 or 2 times per quarter

Homework due dates and late work policy---

It is expected that the work you turn in will be <u>your own effort</u> and that it be completely done in **your own handwriting when possible**. Copying from a friend, online resource or picture is not considered to be of your own effort. For an assignment to be done on time it <u>must be done before the bell rings, otherwise it is late!</u> If you have not completed a daily homework assignment, quiz, composition, conversation, or skit on-time or within the allotted sick days, it will receive a loss of a proficiency grade. It must be <u>thoughtfully completed</u> and turned in BEFORE the last day of the unit. Any work turned in after the unit assessment receives a ZERO unless there are special circumstances.

Translators, Dictionaries and Artificial Intelligence

<u>Online and Google translators are NOT to be used.</u> Translators are not **your own effort** and will be treated as cheating. They do not work well and it is obvious when used. I never expect anything above what you have learned! If used, you will receive 0 credit for that assignment. If you need to look up a word and do not have a dictionary, use <u>www.wordreference.com</u>. It is a wonderful online dictionary. Its app is also a great tool.

AI tools like ChatGPT have the potential to do your work for you just like Google Translate. Doing so would be cheating. AI tools also have the potential to be very useful tools to help us learn and practice. Hopefully, we'll get to explore them together in class this year. Unless you've been given specific directions about how and when to use them, do not use AI tools for your coursework.

Cheating

Cheating is defined in our school handbook and may be as simple as copying someone's work or, **in our class**, **using a translating tool or utilizing any AI (artificial intelligence)**. It could also be taking a picture of completed work and working off of that. Or copying off a completed worksheet online. The cheating protocol will be followed as stated in the handbook with phone calls home and may receive a 0 in the gradebook and office notification. All consequences will be addressed in conjunction with the main office.

Absences

If you know you will be gone from class, please check our weekly folder and pick up your material beforehand.

Lesson plans will be written out in the Weekly Folder in SCHOOLOGY by first day of the school week by 8 am. There will be a WEEKLY PowerPoint that you must look at to get any additional practice or instructions for the day. Then any links, activities and more will be in the folder.

<u>Missing class</u>-If you miss a day, you are expected to go to Schoology and look into the weekly folder. Look at the PowerPoint and the day that you miss. Go through the notes and practice we do in class. There is no way to make up our in-class games so you are expected to practice your Spanish by doing the Chapter Quizlet or going to Conjuguemos. In Schoology, there is a link or spot for ABSENT students to turn in their work (and is the same link as for late work.

If you have an excused absence without advanced notice, you will be given the number of days you were absence plus one more to complete your make-up work as stated in school policy. Remember, this is just days, not specifically A or B days. The best time for make-up tests and extra help is before or after school or during a WIN session. <u>No class time will be</u> <u>used to make up work!</u> If you have a study hall you would like to use to make up a test, please come and get a pass <u>to come to</u> my classroom before or after class.

There is no credit for unexcused absences and unexcused starts after missing 10 minutes of class time, there is no credit for anything done that day.

Supplies needed in School & at Home:

- 1. Sturdy Folder
 - The expectation is that students will be HAND writing their notes on paper or their online notebook. Research shows that this helps students retain the new vocabulary/information better when they see it, process it, write it and hear it.

- I do have note sheets that students can use but they still have to write the Spanish vocabulary on those sheets (mostly made of pictures).
- 2. Writing utensil of choice
- 3. iPad with Schoology, OneNote, Safari, camera access and needed apps

There is no textbook to take home. Realidades textbooks may be used in class occasionally. An online version or a physical book is available upon request. Please talk with me if you would like one.
