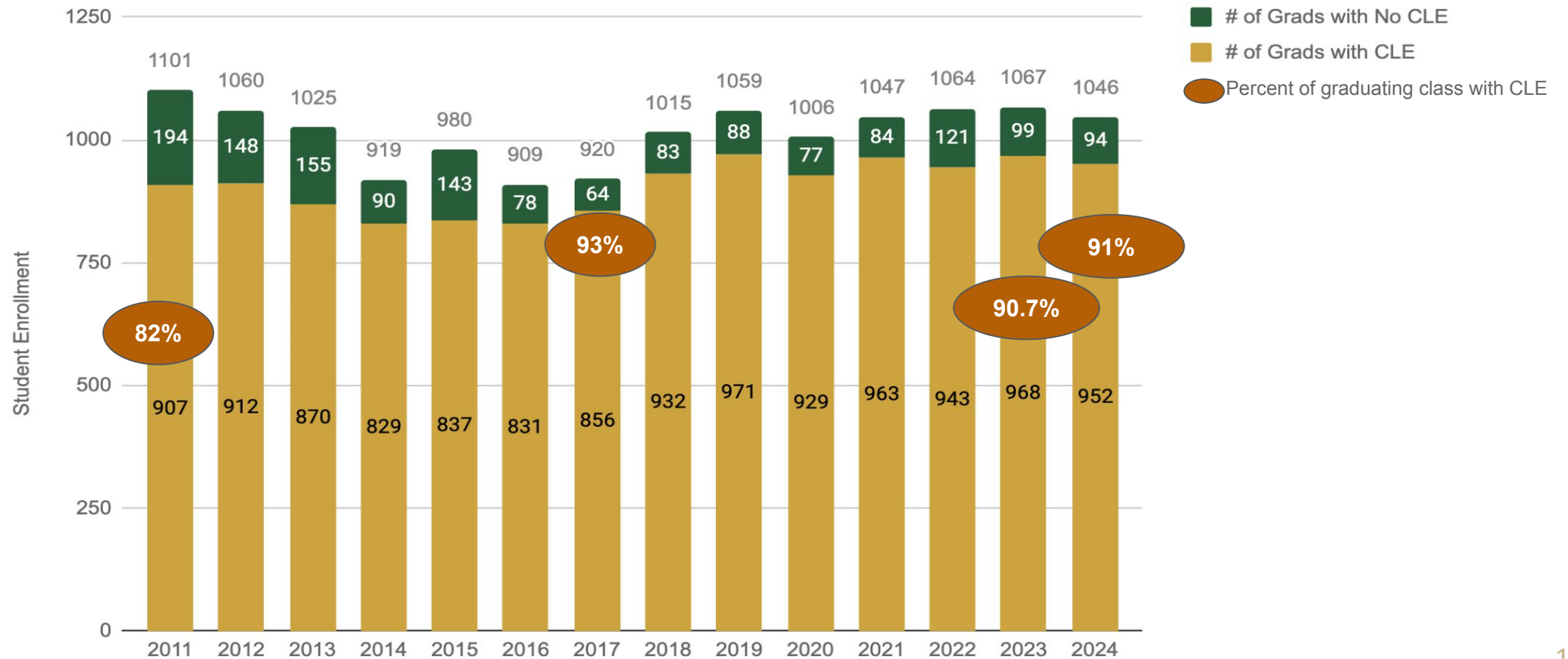

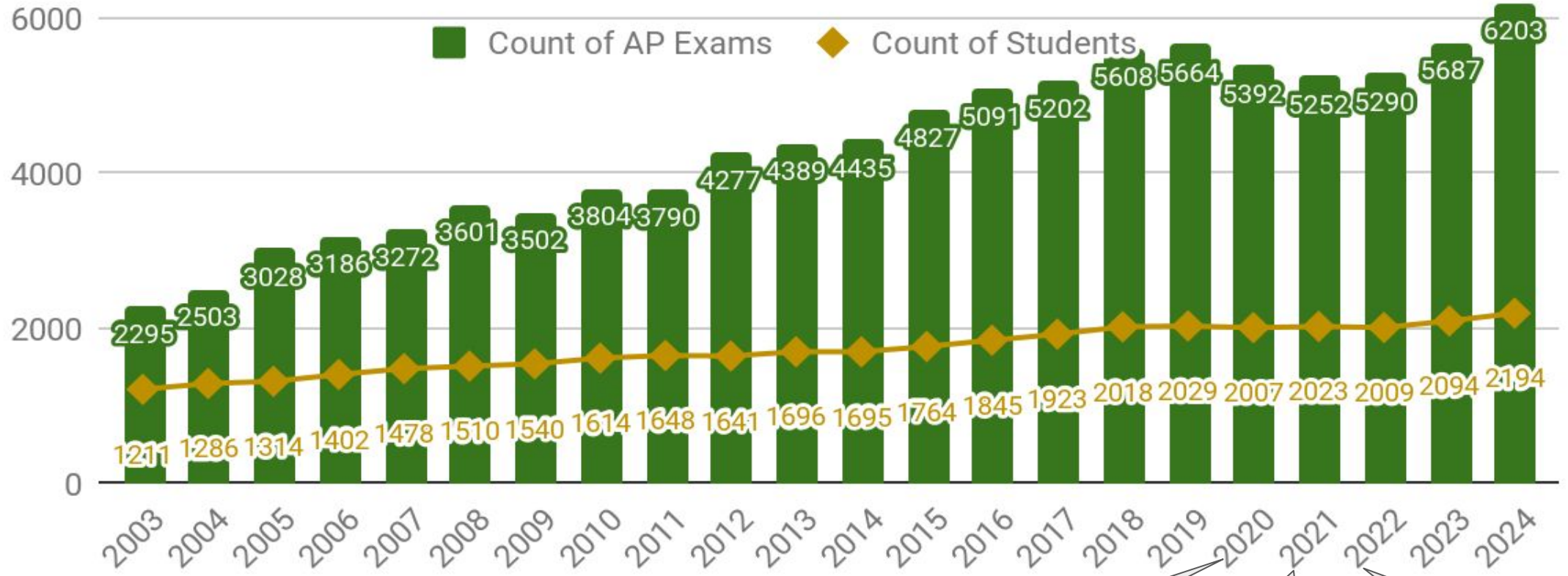

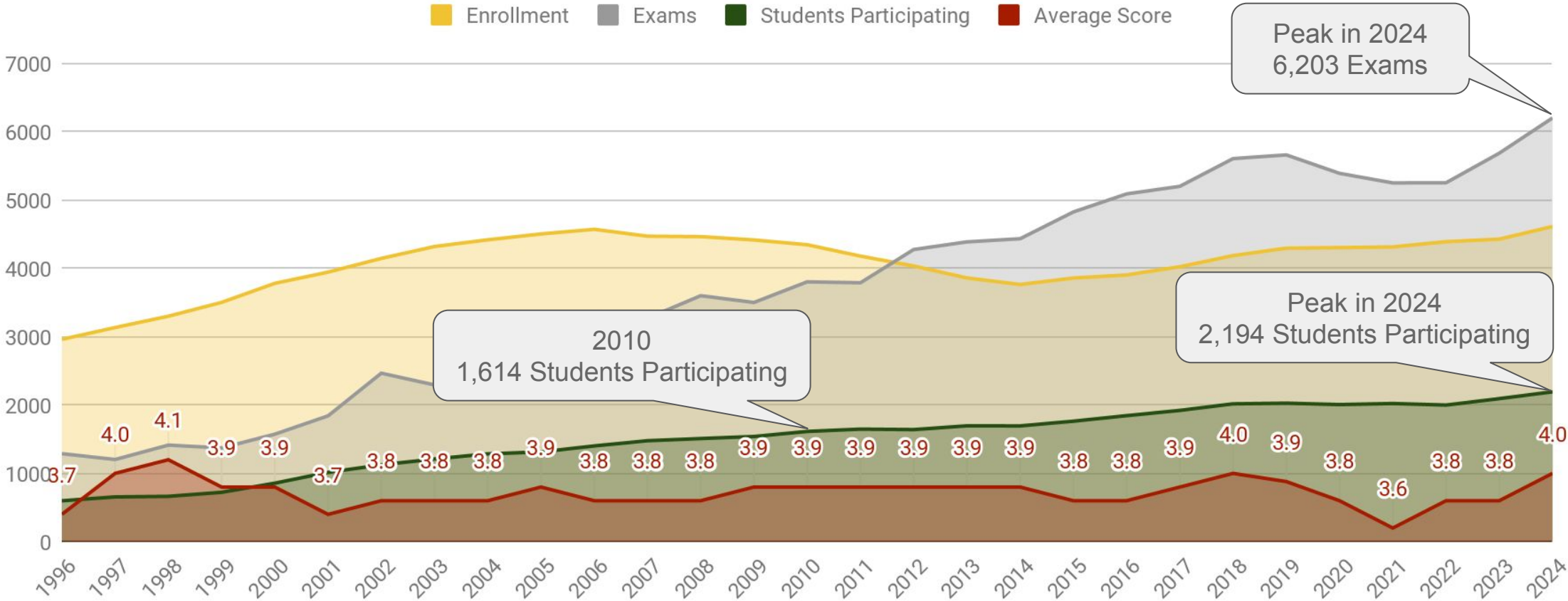

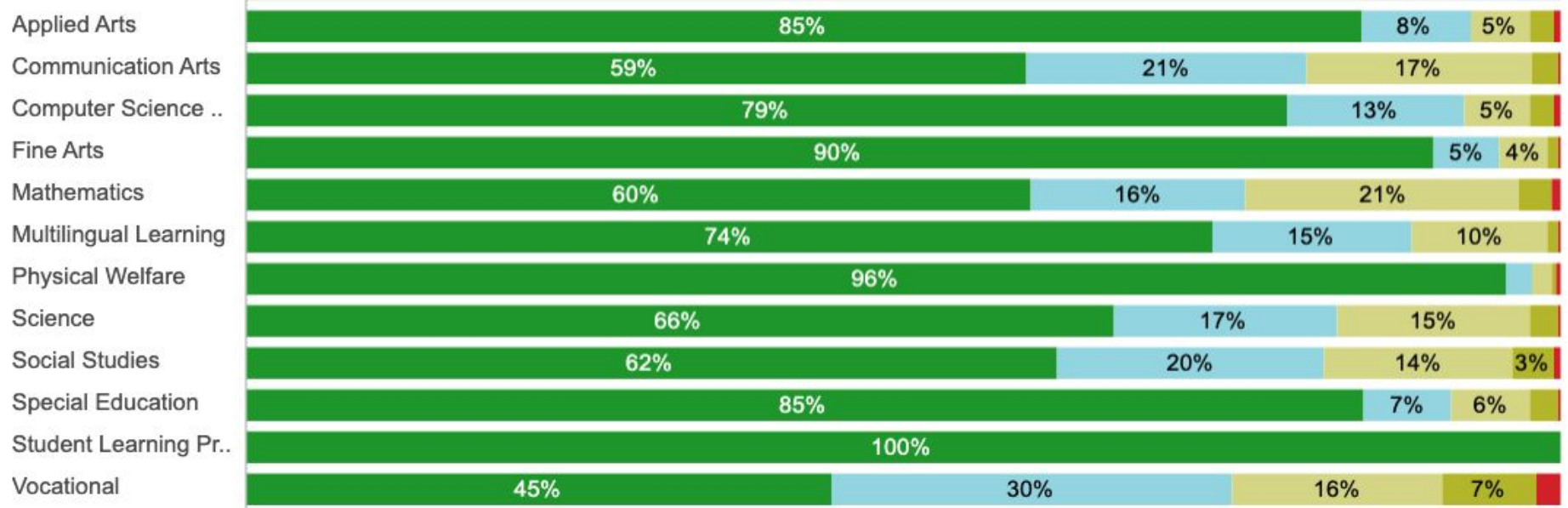
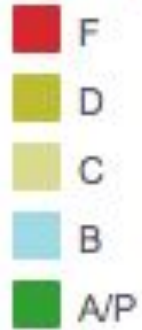

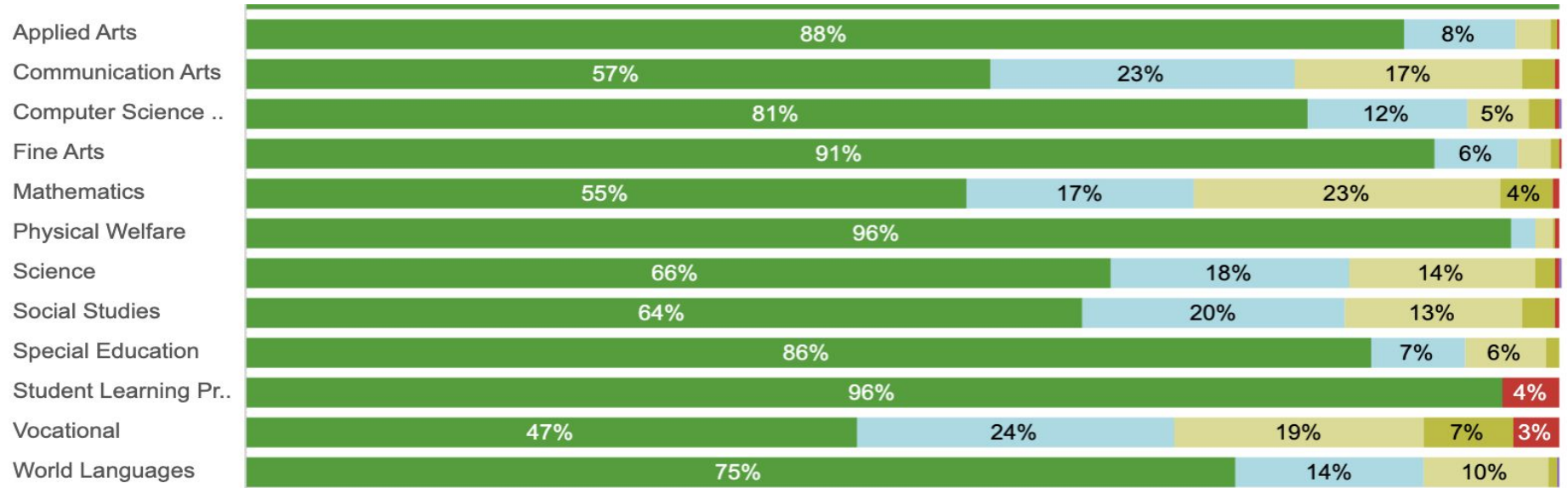

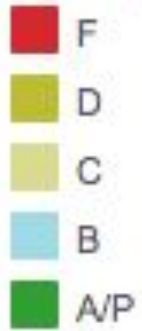

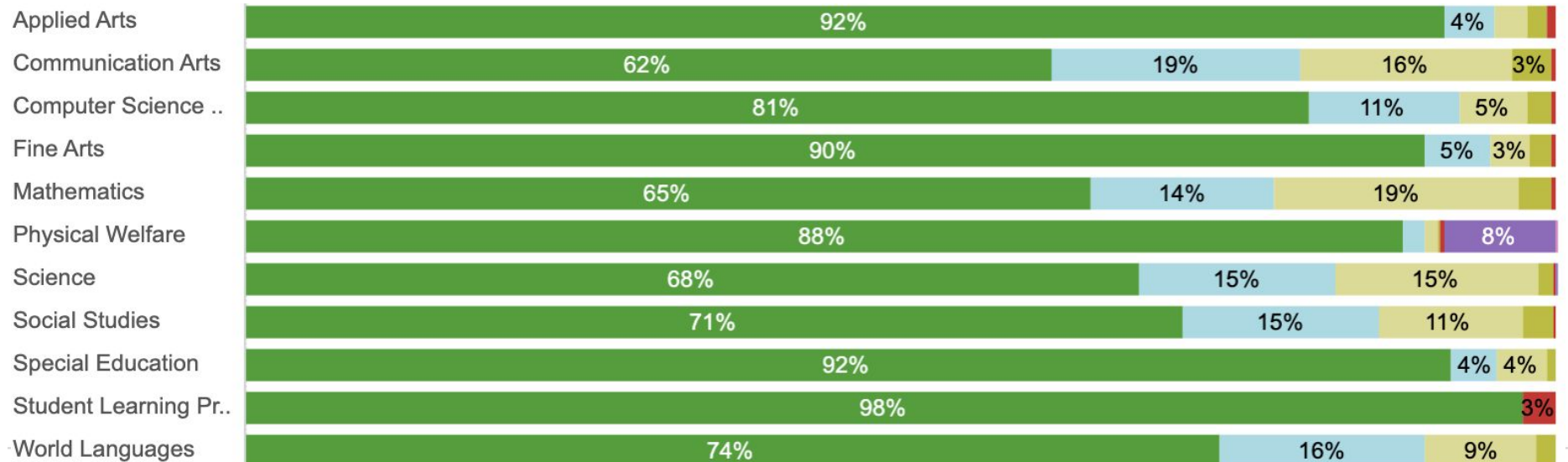


Sem 2 Final Grade Distribution by Division

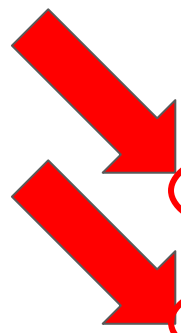

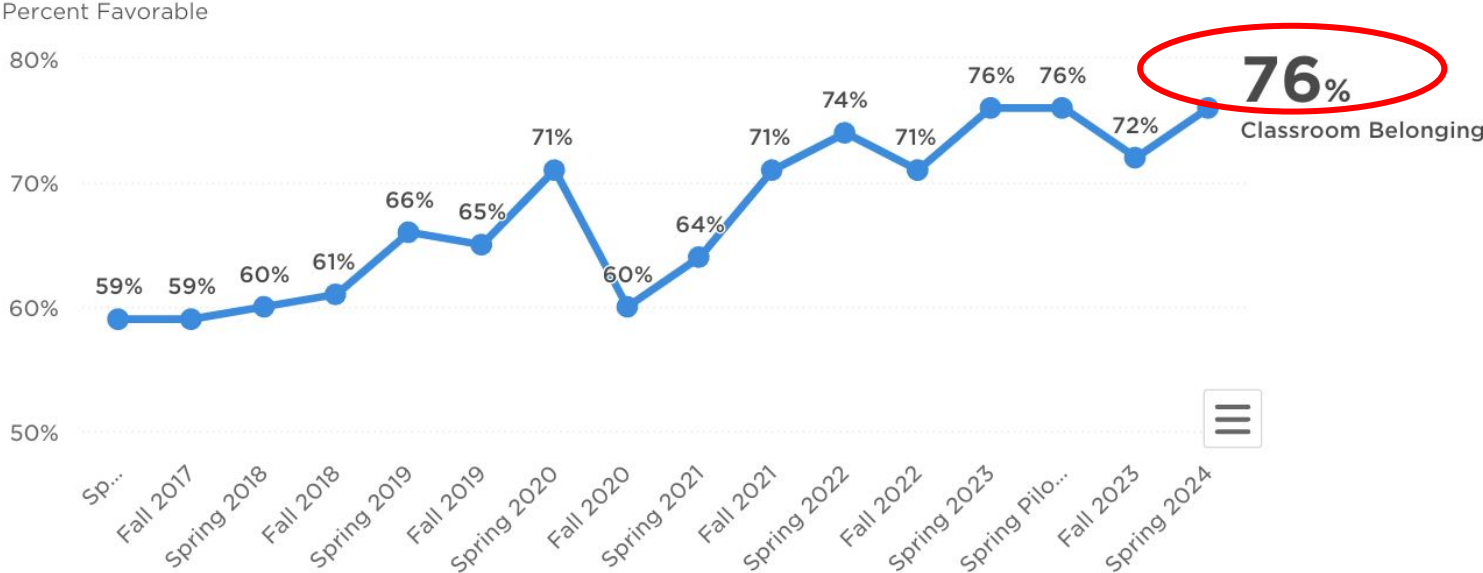

How have results changed over time?

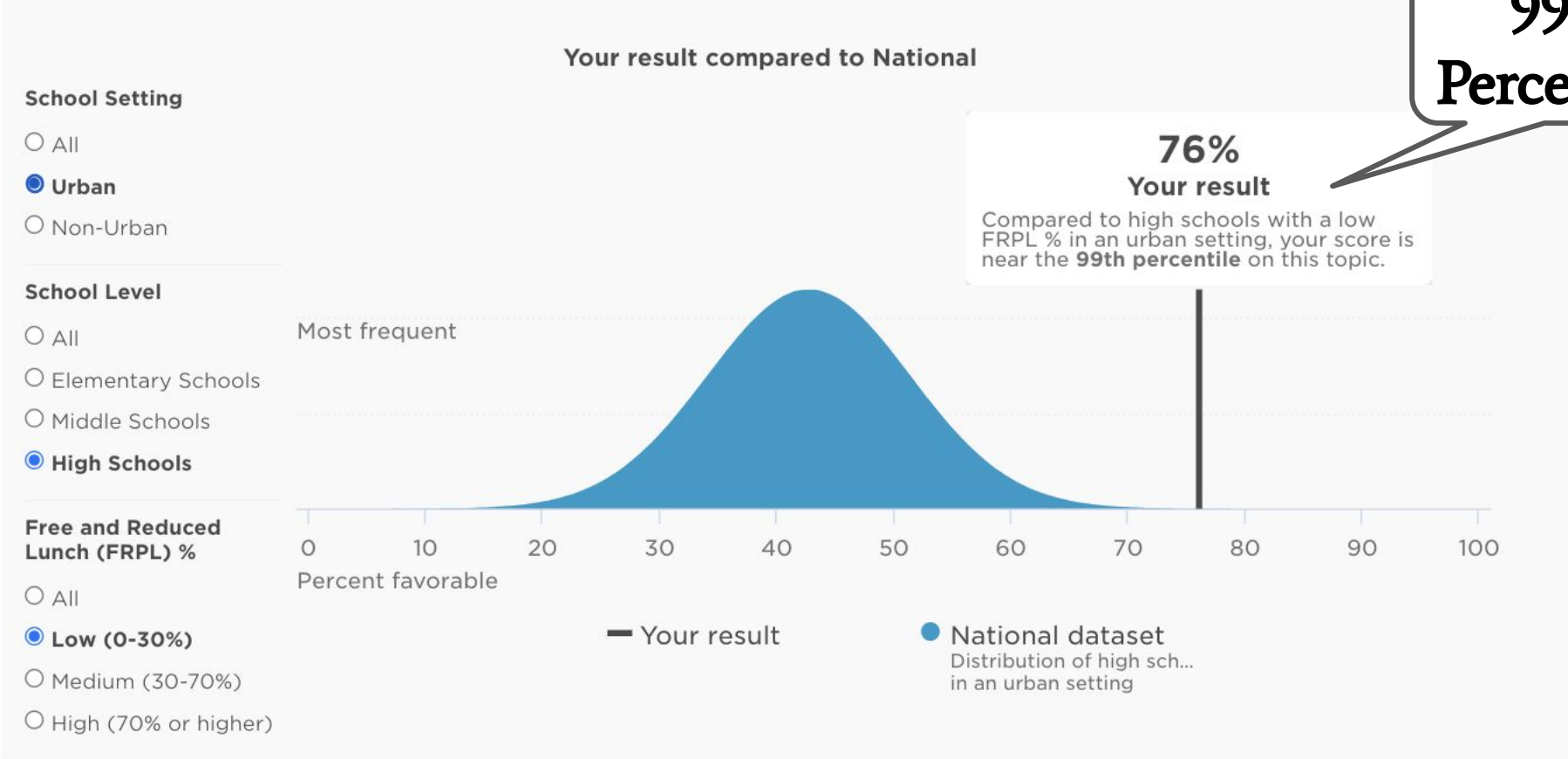

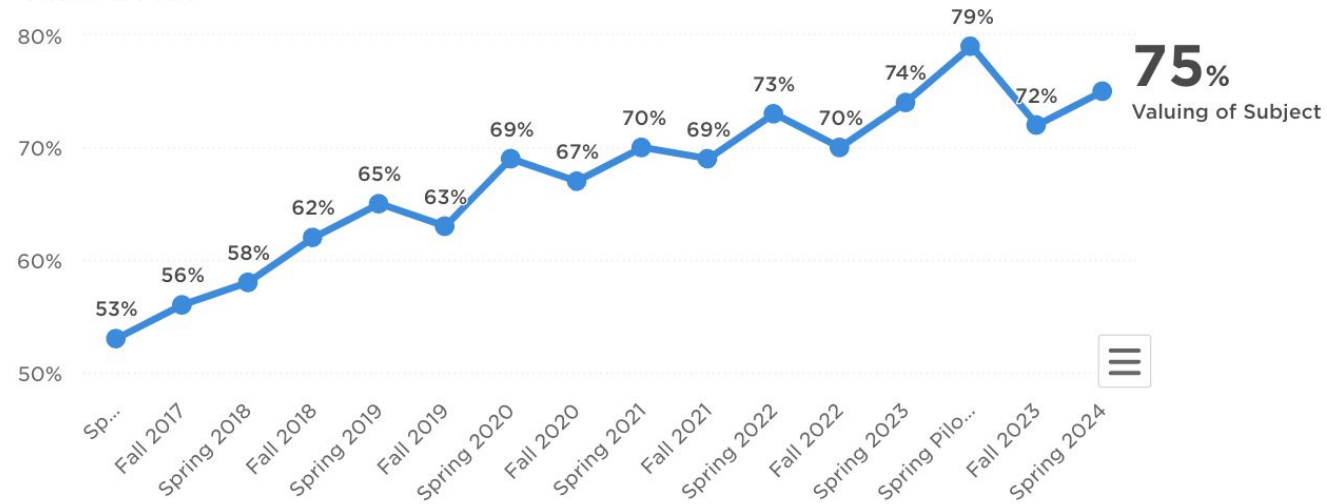

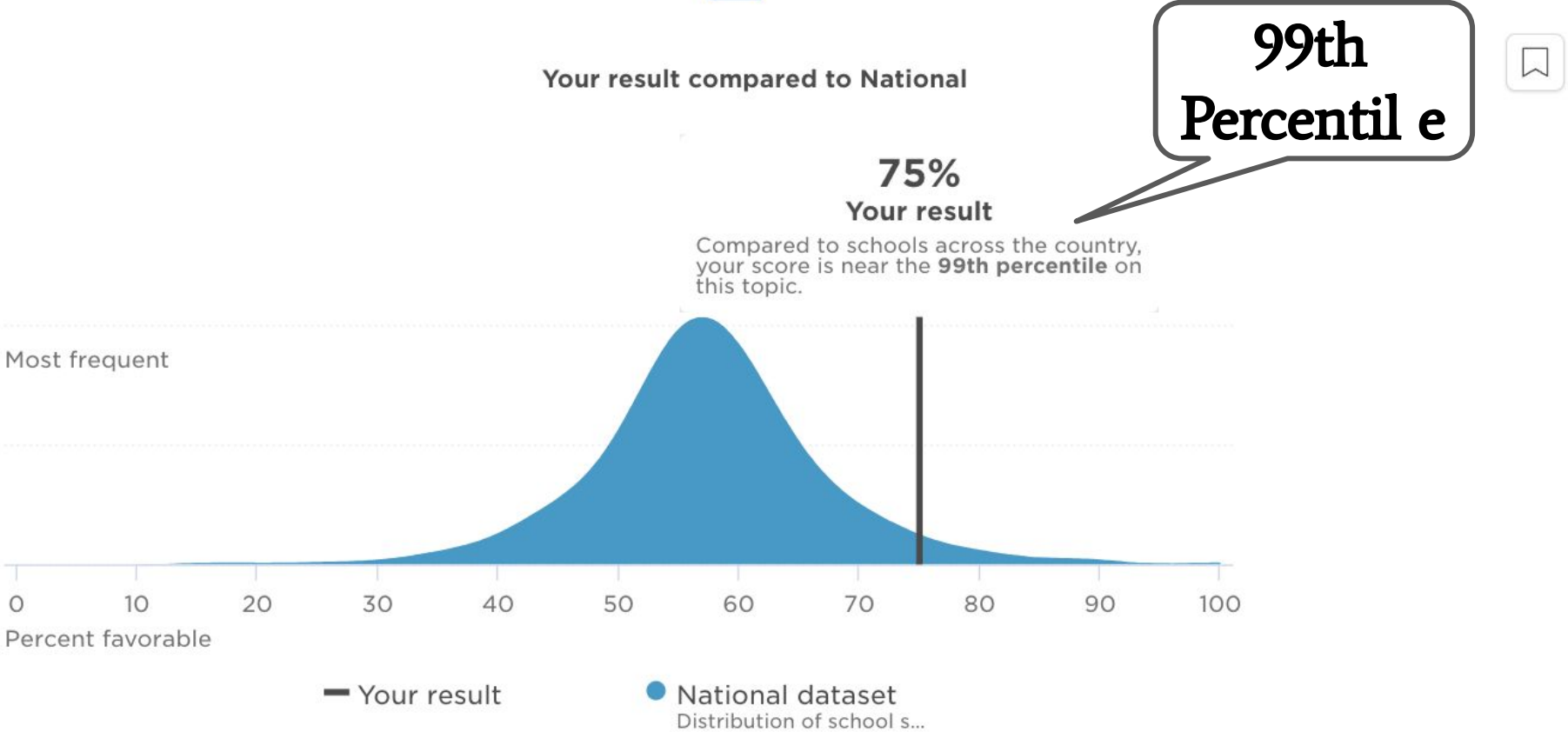

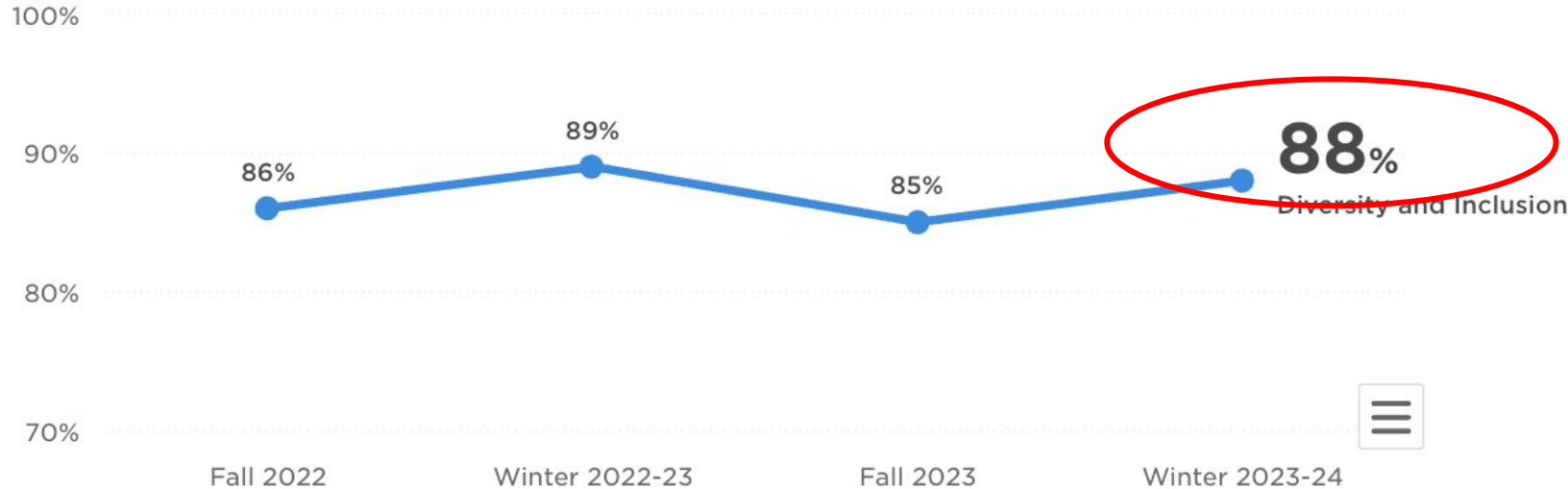

How diverse, integrated, and fair school is for students from different races, ethnicities, or cultures

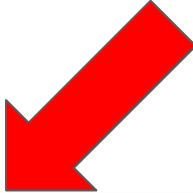
How have results changed over time?

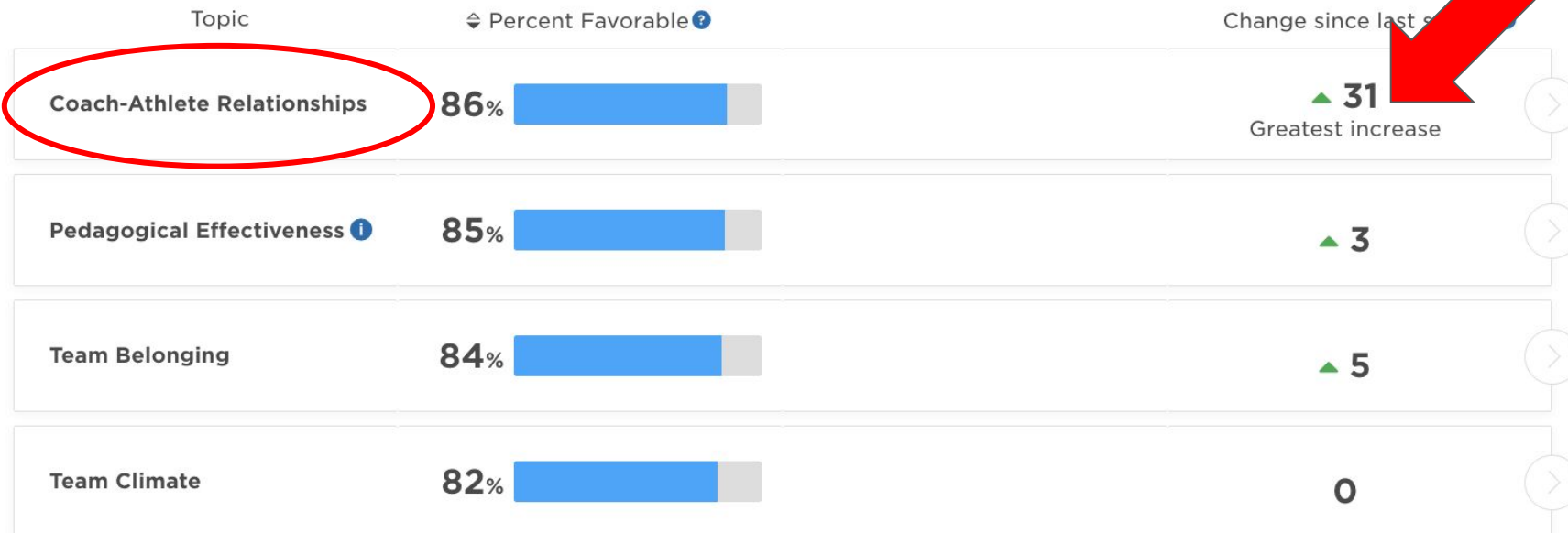
