If you suspect bullying or harassment is occurring, please report it immediately. Salt Lake City School District is committed to providing a working and learning environment free from bullying, hazing, harassment, discrimination, and retaliation.

DEFINITION OF BULLYING



Bullying differs from conflict in that it is:

- Repeated over time
- Intended to cause distress or harm
- Imbalanced in power and/or strength

Harassment is a form of bullying against a protected class.

REPORTING PROCEDURES



If you suspect your student is the target of bullying or harassment, there are several ways to voice your concerns:

- Speak with the school principal, assistant principal, or school counselor

- Complete a Request for Investigation Form (link on district homepage under the button labeled "File a Non-Discrimination/Title IX/ Bullying Complaint")
