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SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY

Agoura High School is located in Los Angeles County, just west of the San Fernando Valley, one of two high schools in the Las Virgenes Unified School District. Most of our students reside in the cities of Agoura Hills, Westlake Village, and Calabasas, as well as unincorporated areas of the Santa Monica Mountains. The Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) awarded Agoura High School its highest-level accreditation in 2020 of six years. Agoura High School was named an International Baccalaureate World School in February 2009, joining 84 other schools in California with this distinction.

GRADING


Agoura High School reports weighted and unweighted GPAs.

GPA: Calculated on a four-point scale where A = 4, B = 3, C = 2, D = 1, & F = 0. AP, IB and most Honors Courses are given an extra grade point in the weighted GPA. Honors Courses that are weighted have a "+" on the transcript. College courses added to the transcript are not weighted and are only given one semester of high schol credit.

SCHOOL DAY

Our school day is a modified block:

- Monday: Six 47-minute periods
- <u>Tuesday Wednesday</u>: Three 80-minute rotating odd/even periods with a 59 minute 7th period. 47-min instructional support period
- <u>Thursday-Friday</u>: Three 93-minute rotating odd/even periods with a 59 minute 7th period

STUDENT ACTIVITIES

Agoura High School believes that students connecting with their passions and interests creates rewarding scholastic experiences.

Academically, unique elective experiences allow students to express themselves and learn teamwork (including Yearbook and Student Leadership). AHS' inclusive environment encourages students to get involved in one of the 60+ clubs on campus (or to create their own student group). A lighthouse school for spirit, annual traditions, and student voice, AHS truly nurtures the social and emotional needs of students.

SPANISH DUAL IMMERSION

Our Spanish Dual Immersion program is a type of bilingual education for acquiring two languages by integrating native English speakers and native Spanish speakers in content and literacy instruction in both languages. Standard school subjects are taught in one of two languages. Beginning in kindergarten, the Spanish-speaking teacher teaches Spanish Language Arts and Social Studies while the English-speaking teacher teaches English Language Arts and Math. Students are in the Dual Immersion program through middle school, and enter their freshman year of high school in our "Spanish for Spanish Speakers" classes.

VISUAL & PERFORMING ARTS, FILM/BROADCASTING, & PRODUCTION DESIGN

Multiple Pathways: Visual Arts, Performing Arts (Theatre/Music/Dance), Film & Broadcasting, Production Engineering/Design, Costume and Make Up. Students may complete IB Music Certification alongside participating in nationally recognized performing ensembles. Various courses offered are designed to give students Professional and Career Technical Education(CTE) experience through utilizing a state of the art Performing Arts & Edu Center.

INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE (IB)

IB Program aims to develop inquiring, knowledgeable and caring young people who help to create a better and more peaceful world through intercultural understanding and respect. It is a challenging two-year curriculum for students in 11th and 12th grade, which leads to an internationally recognized diploma or individual course certificates that are recognized by the world's leading universities.

AHS has a long standing tradition of athletic excellence that includes numerous League, CIF, and State championships. We are proud of our many Chargers athletes that continue to be acknowledged for All-League, All CIF and All-State honors. Agoura High School is a member of the Marmonte League.

STATE SEAL OF CIVIC ENGAGEMENT




Beginning Fall 2022, LVUSD implemented the California State Seal of Civic Engagement (SSCE) to formally recognize and promote student's excellence in civic education and leadership. This optional program can be a project in the community of the student's choosing or in peer tutoring, peer counseling, the Kinesiology and Sports Medicine Academy, or Outdoor Education. Students apply and interview to be a part of the program. Upon completion, students will earn the State Seal on their transcripts/diplomas.

CAREER TECHNICAL EDUCATION

The Career Technical Education (CTE) programs offer multiyear courses combining academic and technical skills to prepare students for college and careers. Fields like sports medicine, health science, computer technology, entrepreneurship, video production, education, culinary arts, automotive, and robotics are explored through CTE and electives. All CTE courses meet University of California A-G subject requirements, and students also complete hands-on internships.
