

The curriculum is aligned to the AERO Common Core Standards in core subjects and prepares students for higher education in North America, the UK, Europe, Australia, and English-speaking settings. English as an additional language (EAL) and learning support services are available.

AP - ADVANCED PLACEMENT

AISA began offering AP courses in **2007-2008**. In the **2023-2024 school year**, **77 students** sat for **165 exams** in **20 subjects**. In the **2024-2024 school year**, there are **61 students** registered for **160 exams** in 19 subjects. Since **2020**, AISA has had 147 graduates earn an AP Scholar Award or better, including **12 members** of the Class of **2025** achieving this distinction in Grade 11. , Various AP course options are offered to prepare our students for admission into the best universities globally. AISA is one of only four schools in Africa to offer the **AP Capstone Program**, which was implemented in **2016-17**.

GRADING SYSTEM

The High School reports grades on a traditional **A-F scale**. Grades are generated from standards-aligned student achievement, primarily on summative tasks and semesterly exams.


