

AISA is a US Department of State Overseas School and offers a broad and balanced American-style education. The curriculum is aligned to the AERO Common Core Standards in core subjects and prepares students for higher education in North America, the UK, Europe, Australia, and English-speaking settings. AISA offers a variety of electives, including Art, Music, Theater, PE, Design, and World Languages, particularly French and Spanish. English as an additional language (EAL) and learning support services are available.

AlSA offers after school activities including Model United Nations (MUN), National Honors Society (NHS), Student Council, Community Service options, and interest-based clubs. In athletics, AlSA competes in the West African International School Activities League (WAISAL) in basketball, soccer, swimming, volleyball, robotics, mathematics competitions, and band.

AP-ADVANCED PLACEMENT

AISA began offering AP courses in 2007-2008. In the 2023-2024 school year, 77 students sat for 165 exams in 20 subjects. In the 2024-2024 school year, there are 61 students registered for 160 exams in 19 subjects. Since 2020, AISA has had 147 graduates earn an AP Scholar Award or better, including 12 members of the Class of 2025 achieving this distinction in Grade 11., Various AP course options are offered to prepare our students for admission into the best universities globally. AISA is one of only four schools in Africa to offer the AP Capstone Program, which was implemented in 2016-17.

GRADING SYSTEM

The High School reports grades on a traditional **A-F scale.** Grades are generated from standards-aligned student achievement, primarily on summative tasks and semesterly exams.

COVID-19 AND CIVIL UNREST

Due to the global pandemic, AISA moved to online learning from March 2020 to October 2020. During the 2022/23 school year, students moved to online learning due to civil unrest in Nigeria from October 2022 to January 2023.




