DCTC & CTE Presentation and Update

- Overview of DCTC
 - 9 schools in the consortium
 - Success of DCTC because of the uniqueness of Downriver community – common sense/common values
 - Have added at least one new program for the past seven years – showing DCTC can respond to the demands of the communities
- DCTC Reporting Requirements
 - Perkins – Federal grant, monthly/yearly/bi-annual requirements
 - CTEIS – State funded, reporting on program outcomes
 - Student Service Coordinator, compliance monitoring, programming from grades 5-12
- Start-up 2024
 - Numbers are up
 - Total CTE - 23-24: 2754 – 24-25: 3034
 - Transfer at bus hub, last year: 580, this year 725 – numbers is classes are higher because of self-driving students
 - Dual Enrollment – last year: HFC 22/WCCCD 31 – this year: HFC 33/WCCCD 52
- Future of DCTC
 - Final stages of closing on the Trenton Athletic Club
 - Working with instructors and districts to best represent in the new building
