Seizure Recognition and First Aid program

The Seizure Recognition and First Aid trainings provide information that will increase the knowledge, skills, and confidence in recognizing seizures and safely administering seizure first aid.

Seizure Recognition and First Aid Certification training, offered both Live and On Demand (75 - 90 minutes)

Behavioral Health Provider Courses

Epilepsy and psychiatric disorders have a bidirectional relationship. This means that not only people with epilepsy are at higher risk of developing psychiatric disorders, but people with primary psychiatric disorders are at higher risk of developing epilepsy.



Designed for social workers, psychologists, nurse practitioners, psychiatry advanced practice providers and counselors.



Seizure Safe Schools Courses

This program provides an overview of seizures and epilepsy, seizure first aid, seizure action plans, rescue therapies, seizure emergencies and how to support students in school settings.

Seizure Training for School Personnel is designed for people who work with children and youth in school settings.
