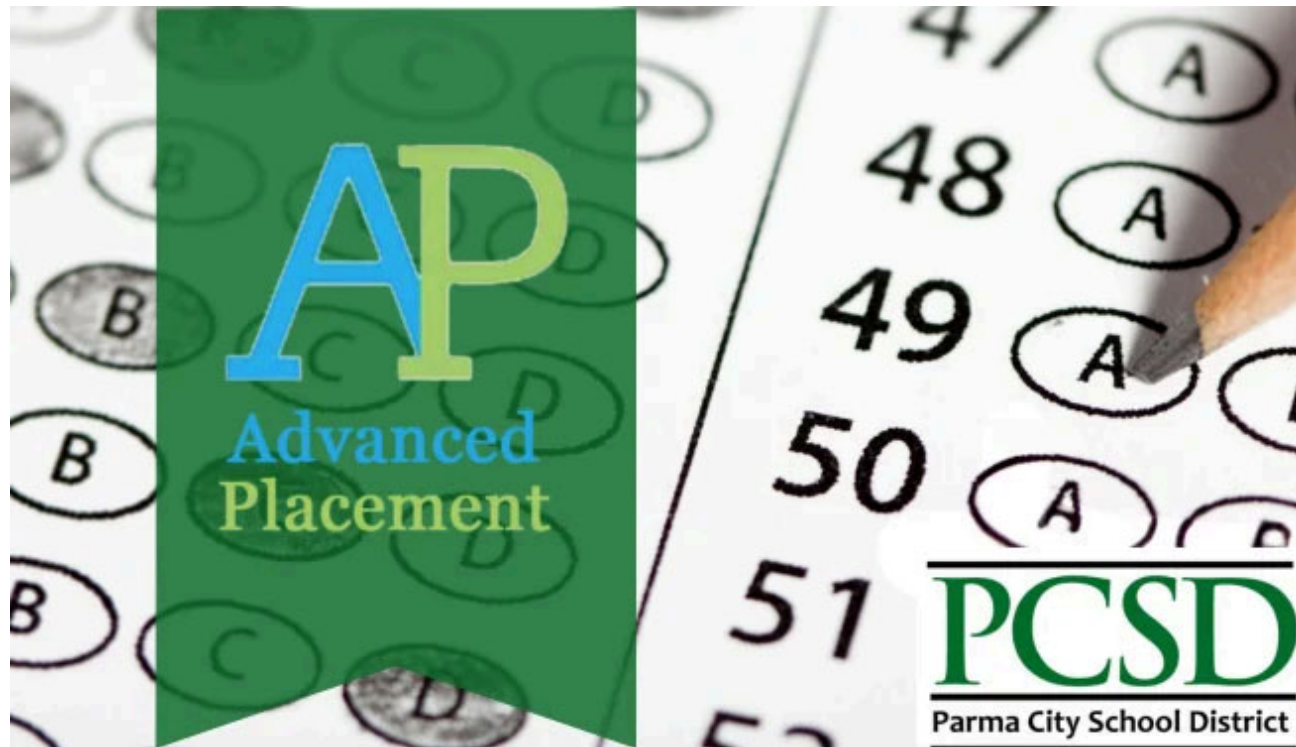

Spotlight On AP Excellence

Celebrating Our Students & Teachers

We often celebrate our incredible Career Technical Education (CTE) courses and programs as a “Crown Jewel” of our district. We are, rightfully, proud of the fact that approximately two thirds of our juniors and seniors participate in a CTE program that helps them earn both college credits and professional certifications before they graduate. This summer, though, we would like to also highlight the impressive performances of our students who enroll in Advanced Placement (AP) courses.

Most colleges and universities will grant either credit or advanced placement on course ladders to students who score at least a “3” on an AP exam. We are extremely proud that 288 of our high school students completed at least one exam at the end of the 2023-24 school year. Of these, 72% earned at least one score of “3”, demonstrating outstanding achievement and helping to save their families college tuition expenditures when they begin their post-secondary experiences. In addition to congratulating our students, we also must express our gratitude to the teachers who dedicate countless hours of study to gaining certification to lead these most rigorous courses. We certainly cannot offer such a wide array of opportunities without such dedicated staff members prepared to meet the challenges of gaining their AP credential.

The following list indicates courses in which the mean score was above “3.” As you read through, please note the variety of curricular offerings that we are very proud to continue to provide.

Mean Score of “3” or above: 2-D Art/Design, Biology, Calculus A/B, Chemistry, Drawing, English Literature and Composition, European History, French, Macroeconomics, Psychology, Spanish, Statistics, US Government and Policy, US History
