Dues: Dues cover all graduation related expenses and senior events. They DO NOT cover prom, any sort of pictures, a yearbook, or any additional items you may want to buy. Dues can be paid [HERE](#)

- \$185 for rest of semester starting 2/1/25
 - Dues paid by 2/28/25 will also include a senior t-shirt
 - Dues MUST be paid by 2/28/25 for students to participate in the senior picnic during March Madness
- Any dues paid starting 4/14/25 will also include a Scholastic Images shipping fee, since this will be too late to include in the mass cap and gown pick up on 4/16/25.
