



How to Log-In to NC Digital Library: A Step-by-Step Guide

1. First, get to Overdrive using one of two options:
 - A. Go to ncdigital.overdrive.com.
 - B. Go to arlnc.org, and then select either [NC Digital Library](#) or [NC Kids](#) Digital.
2. Click “Sign In” (button on the upper right of the screen).
3. Select your library from the list. You will need to *select Albemarle Regional Library* (the first library for NCDL, second for NC Kids).
4. Enter your Student Number for your Log-In.
5. Enter your PIN number, which is the *last four digits* of your student number.
6. Search for the title(s) you would like to borrow. Click on the word **BORROW** under the title.
7. A pop-up window will appear. Select how long you want access to this title. (You can choose 7, 14, or 21 days.)
8. *If the title you want is unavailable*, you can place a hold on it. Click PLACE A HOLD, and you will be emailed when it is available for you.
9. Enjoy your reading! Remember, the titles you borrow will automatically be “returned” at the end of the time period you selected above, so you will never have overdue fines using NCDL.

Note: Just like the physical branches of ARL, NCDL has many offerings beyond “just” books. Explore and find everything from books to magazines to audiobooks and movies. Use any aspect of the arlnc.org website.

All of NCDL works from a computer by using the steps above. If you want to use OverDrive on a device (tablet, smartphone, etc.), you will want to get the “Libby” app. Learn more at <https://www.overdrive.com/apps/libby/> or libbyapp.com.
