Welcome & Introductions

Approval of Minutes and Agenda

Principal's Report:

- Mrs. Goude shared information for the upcoming STEM Family Night. She shared that more information will be coming out soon for our Family Thanksgiving Luncheon.
- Mrs. Goude shared that our CREW Days will now be held on the first Friday of each month to be able to collect all data for DoJo points iReady goals for the entire month.
- She reviewed Anchored in Achievement Day that will be held October 25, 2024.

Old Business:

- Mrs. Goude shared information that was found about after school clubs from other schools. There are only 2 elementary schools in the district that has after school clubs. She found out that those clubs are being funded by grants.

    - Typical Math – 53.3%
    - Typical Reading – 52.49%
    - Stretch Math – 25.3%
    - Stretch Reading – 34.25%
  - Reviewed SC Ready – decrease in all areas
  - Reviewed iReady Projected Achievement
  - Reviewed the district's 75 in 5 goal

- Shared the plan of increasing our scores with L.I.F.T.
